came to the Chancery for an interview today to report an allegation of abuse by Rev. George Roulier, which took place at St. Angela's Church in Mattapan around 1977. (uncertain of the date.) was 11 years old and used to help his father who worked as a [redacted] in the Church. One Sunday when closing up [redacted] encountered Father as they were both going out the back door. According to [redacted], Father grabbed him from behind and put his hands down [redacted]'s pants. [redacted] reacted violently, threw Father against the wall, and ran out of the Church. He never told anyone because they would not believe him anyway. He recalls many times Father hugging him and feeling uncomfortable.

[redacted] is the youngest of [redacted] children. His family was very religious. His mother had [redacted] brothers priests and one sister a nun. Her name is Sister [redacted] and is still living. [redacted]'s parents now live in [redacted]. He has always had relationship problems with both of them. He was on alcohol and drugs for over 7 years. He no longer uses either. He is married to a young woman named [redacted] and they have a little boy named [redacted]. [redacted] feels he needs some counseling to help resolve the anger he feels toward his parents. They are elderly and he wants to reconcile with them. Just the other day he said that he exploded again and told them that he hated them. They, too, are upset by his attitude and would be willing to go for counseling to resolve this.

I did not give him a list of therapists nor have him sign a waiver until I spoke with you. This should probably be handled by the Oblates of Mary Immaculate.
