## Rev Herold M Nuwer

Rev. Herold M. Nuwer, 75, was the son of Michael and Irene Herold Nuwer. He was a graduate of Canisius College and attended Christ the King Seminary, St. Bonaventure University, and was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Buffalo, New York on February 25, 1961. He served on the Buffalo Missionary Apostolate at St. Brendan, Almond.

He was assistant pastor at St. Nicholas, Buffalo and held positions as administrator at Sacred Heart and St. Nicholas, both in Buffalo; at St. Augustine, Clarence Center and St. George, Niagara Falls.

In 1988, Father Nuwer was named pastor of Our Lady of Loretto Parish, Buffalo, where he served for nine years. In 1988, he became pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish in Ransomville, where he remained until his retirement in 2004. In 1979, Father Nuwer was recognized with the Human Relations Award from the Buffalo branch of the NAACP for his work in the community and at St. Nicholas. He had mediated tensions between the largely African-American parish and the Diocese of Buffalo. In 1993, he was named Moderator of the Year by the Diocesan Union of Holy Name Societies.
