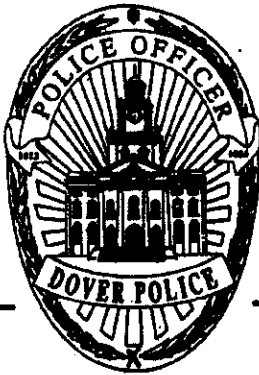

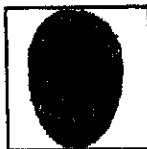

Narrative

On 11/14/02, I received a call at home from Captain Colarusso. He told me that Chief Fenniman

had received an e-mail from Donna Sytek, the chair of the Task Force on Sexual Misconduct for the Bishop of Manchester. He told me that the e-mail was notifying Chief Fenniman that a victim had reported, by e-mail, that he had been sexually assaulted as a teenager by a priest who was also the principal at St. Thomas Aquinas High School.

At approximately 1010, I called [REDACTED]. I introduced myself and told him that Chief Fenniman had received a copy of the e-mail that he had sent to the task force and that the e-mail had been forwarded to me. He said that he understood and was expecting my call.

He told me that he has seen the recent news coverage of the agreement between the Diocese in Manchester and the NH Attorney General's Office and felt the need to "stand up and be counted". He said that he recognizes the courage involved in coming forward and said that if everyone had remained silent, then none of the progress that has been made in recent months would be possible. He said that he has kept his abuse a secret for long enough and he feels that it is necessary to tell someone, besides his family, about what had happened to him.

[REDACTED] told me that he was fondled "about a half a dozen times" during the summer of 1960 (he was 15-years-old at the time). He explained that St. Thomas Aquinas High School had just been built and that he was working as a janitor at the school during the summer. He said that the principal, who was also a priest, was a man named Roland Veillette. [REDACTED] said that Veillette lived in an apartment in the basement of the school and that was where the abuse took place. He said that the abuse began as "frolicking, kidding around and wrestling" but that Veillette fondled him before the wrestling was over.

He said that he knew of at least two other boys who were abused at the same time. He said that he cannot remember the name of one of the children and that the other, whom he did not want to name, is an "active person" in the City of Dover. He said that some of the other victims reported their abuse right away and he recalled that the situation "exploded at St. Joseph's Church". He said that Veillette was sent "up North" to either the Colebrook or Bartlett area.

I explained that, due to the fact that the offense occurred in 1960, it was outside the statute of limitations for a criminal prosecution. At that point, he added that Veillette is deceased. He told me that he plans to speak with Investigator Fowler from the Attorney General's Office so that his story can be officially told. He also told me that he plans to talk to an attorney but not necessarily for a lawsuit. He said that he has spoken with Father Arsenaault from the Manchester Diocese who told him that an attorney from the Diocese might want to meet with him. He said that he did not plan on doing that until he spoke to an attorney of his own.

I told him that I would be generating a report about our conversation and that it would be available for the NH Attorney General's Office. He said that was fine. I also told him that I would be contacting Allison Vachon and telling her about our conversation. He said that was fine and thanked me for my time.

On 12/16/02, I spoke with Allison Vachon and we discussed our conversations with [REDACTED]. She provided me with her fax number (271-2110) and asked me to fax a copy of this report to her when it is completed. I told her that I would.

Due to the fact that this offense is outside of the statute of limitations and because the suspect is deceased, I recommend that this case be closed.

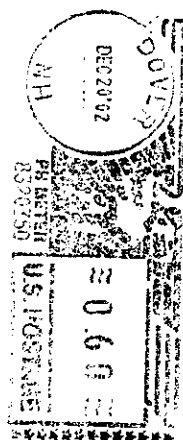

MEMORANDUM

After learning of FATHER LOWER'S apparent suicide, called CAPT. HAL BROWN who is a police officer in KEENE and a part-time ME in Cheshire County who handled the LOWER unattended death. BROWN indicated the body located was in fact LOWER-6/19/45 and the suicide occurred probably on 12/28/02. The body was found on 12/29/02 in a wooded area. A suicide note was located with the body, along with a diet Pepsi and prescription drugs. The actual location of the body was off BOG RD. in ENFIELD, NH, which is an area where LOWER grew up.

BROWN stated the body was found leaned up against a tree (sitting down) app. 100 yards into the woods and LOWER was dressed for being outside. He was carrying a zip up pouch that contained the drugs Oxycontin, Endocet, Xantac, and Vioox. It is believed the drugs were used to overdose and cause his death. There also was a large address book located with the body, which contained the suicide note, and a pencil was found near the body, which was used to write the note, as LOWER sat under the tree.

BROWN indicated the extremities of the body were frozen, as was the head, which would be consistent with LOWER being there app. one day. The suicide note is difficult to read, and due to the evidence, it would appear LOWER was writing the note as he was taking the pills. Asked BROWN to send me a copy of the suicide note. Have received the note and is attached to this memorandum. Also learned from BROWN that the NEW LONDON POLICE have a short note, which was found in LOWER'S residence written on a small note pad. Called NEW LONDON PD and also received a copy of this note, which is attached to this memorandum.

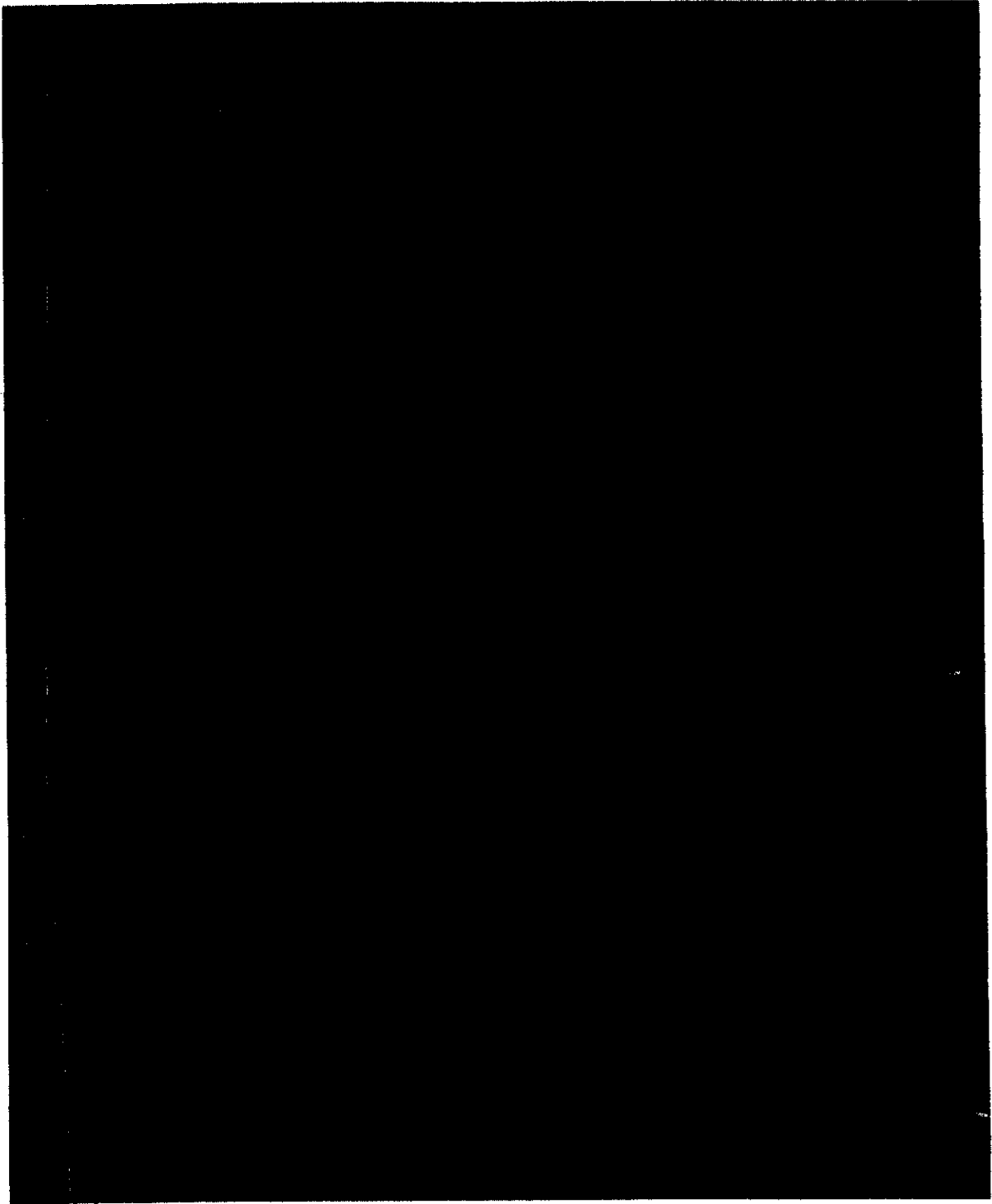

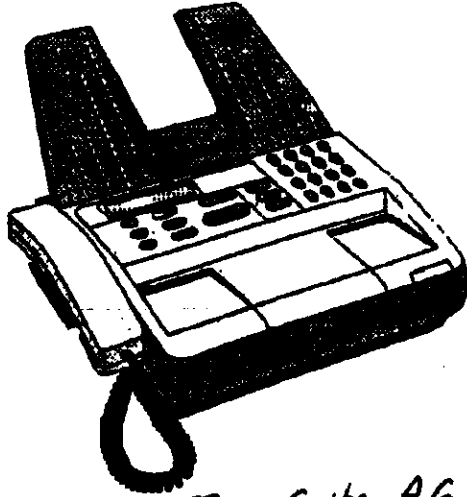

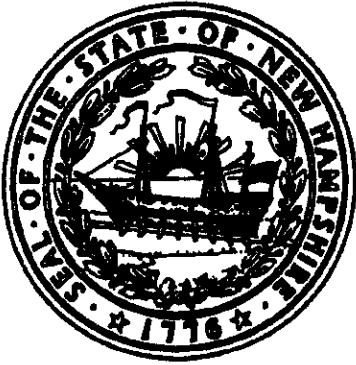

Will and Tony, As a further follow up to my prior email, we have oral information from Father Michael Griffin who confirmed that the accused was indeed Fr. John T. Sullivan. Fr. Griffin said that he came back to visit at the time of the incident. Reportedly he left the area after the incident was reported to (then) Msgr. Christian. Fr. Griffin didn't know where he went. According to Fr. Griffin, Fr. Sullivan is now deceased after being in a nursing home in San Diego, CA. We have no written confirmation about his passing.
