Thank you for updating me on the status of Fr Lirette.

With respect to Fr Osgood and this is what I have learned:

did call the Diocese originally on March 21, 2002 to report the abuse by Fr. Osgood which had occurred in the late 1950's or early 1960's. At that time he told Joe Naff of NH Catholic Charities that he only wanted to report his experiences to the Diocese and not to law enforcement.

on May 7, 2002 and a second letter on September 16, 2002 in Joe sent a follow-up letter to to report the incidents to the NH Attorney General's office or to the which he encouraged Hillsborough County Attorney. Joe did not hear back from him until he received a call from the afternoon of 12/17/03 at 3:00pm. Apparently had recently received an invitation from Joe to attend a retreat day on January 17, 2004. Apparently this letter prompted s call in to Joe. said his mother died this past summer and he had been back in NH which triggered memories of his abuse by Fr. Osgood. In his conversation with Joe Naff, Mr. Osgood asked if the whereabouts of Fr. Osgood was known. Joe told him that he didn't know either his whereabouts or Father Osgood's current status; he only knew that Fr Osgood had reportedly abandoned ministry many years ago. In that he would inquire at the Diocese and would let him know if there was any Joe Naff also told new or further information that he could share with him about Fr. Osgood's status. Joe also asked if he thought some counseling would be helpful to him because of the memories that he has been experiencing and he said that he as been in counseling. (Either Mark or someone from his office spoke with him months ago—we don't know if his status has changed since.) The Diocese then sent a letter last week notifying the bishop in GA that we understand that Mr. Osgood lives in his diocese.

Although I do not believe the Diocese was required to submit this report to the Office of the Attorney General under the Agreement, I am doing so as a matter of courtesy and to keep you apprized of these types of complaints when we believe it may be helpful to do so.

Attached is a report from an individual who lives in Nashua about alleged abuse he suffered in Massachusetts involving a Massachusetts religious priest in 1960 or 1961. The priest is now deceased. We do not have any additional information about the complainant or the accusation other than what is in the attached report. The complainant indicated that he would contact our victim assistance coordinator, but he has not done so. He did not leave a telephone number. We are trying to locate him so that we can follow up.

We do not believe that this is reportable to the Attorney General's office because it does not involve Diocese of Manchester "Church personnel" and did not take place in New Hampshire. The Diocese has made a verbal report to the Archdiocese of Boston and Intends to submit the attached document to the Archdiocese, so that the Archdiocese can submit a report to the MA Attorney General's office. We therefore thought that we should submit the report to the NH Attorney General's office.
