I cannot think of any creative argument that the st. of lim. should be extended in this case. Under any set of circumstances the conduct had to have occurred more than one year ago. Therefore, it is clear that the statute of limitation has expired. I there is nothing we can do from a prosecution prespective on this matter. I would let her know that the st. of lim. has expired and that we are closing the matter.

Obviously there is nothing we can do with the complaint against Fr. Sullivan since he is deceased.







Ms statement was informed that we had reported her allegation against Fr. Talbot to you. She was told that I would be reporting her allegation about Fr. Sullivan to the Attorney General's office as well. She asked for the contact information for the Attorney General's office. She was given the general number for the AG's office and the criminal justice bureau number. She was also given your name. She said that she thinks that you may have tried to contact her, but she did not return your call.
