Please find attached a civil authorities report. I do not believe this report falls under the Agreement, but the Diocese wanted me to file it with you for completeness.

Essentially, the Diocese received a call from a [REDACTED] who was encouraged to contact the Diocese of Manchester by the Archdiocese of Boston.

Ms [REDACTED] reports that her [REDACTED] had disclosed to her in 1997 that he had been abused as a minor by a NH priest who she only as a "Father Al." We do not know when the abuse might have occurred and Ms [REDACTED] did not want to disclose her [REDACTED] name, address or other identifying information. Accordingly, we do not have much information to report.

DEAR MR. DELKER:

FORTY EIGHT(48) YEARS AGO, AT THE AGE OF 14 YEARS, I WAS SEXUALLY MOLESTED BY A NEW HAMPSHIRE PRIEST NAMED MARCEL GENEUREUX. HE HAS BEEN DEAD FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS NOW.

THE ABUSE WENT ON FOR ABOUT TWO YEARS WHILE I WAS A STUDENT AT THE PRESENTATION OF MARY ACADEMY, AN ALL-GIRLS BOARDING SCHOOL IN HUDSON NH. THE PRIEST PERPETRATOR WAS ASSIGNED AS CHAPLAIN THERE BEGINNING IN THE FALL OF 1957. HE WAS AT THAT TIME, AN OBLATE OF MARY IMMACULATE (OMI). THIS PRIEST MADE IT CLEAR NOT TO TELL ANYONE AND HE THREATENED TO FIND ME AND HAUNT ME WHETHER HE WAS STILL ALIVE OR DEAD IF I EVER TOLD ANYONE ABOUT WHAT HE WAS DOING TO ME. AT THE SAME TIME HE WOULD SHOWER ME WITH RELIGIOUS GIFTS AND BOOKS. EVENTUALLY I BECAME VERY UPSET AND WAS AT A LOSS ABOUT WHAT TO DO. I NEVER ASKED TO SEE THAT CHAPLAIN WHEN HE WAS ASSIGNED TO THE SCHOOL, RATHER IT WAS HIM WHO CALLED ME TO HIS OFFICE 2-3 TIMES A WEEK.

ALMOST TWO YEARS LATER IN 1959, MY OLDER SISTER FINALLY CONVINCED ME TO TALK TO A MUCH OLDER PRIEST WHO WAS ALSO AN OBLATE OF MARY IMMACULATE. I TOLD HIM ABOUT WHAT HAD BEEN HAPPENING TO ME. HE IN TURN TOLD THE PRIEST-SUPERIOR OF THE OBLATES AND ALSO INFORMED THE SISTER SUPERIOR AT THE SCHOOL. OVERNIGHT, MARCEL GENEUREUX WAS REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES OF THE SCHOOL. OTHER GIRLS WHO WERE KNOWN TO BE SEEING THAT CHAPLAIN FOR COUNSELING WERE SUMMONED FOR QUESTIONING. I DO NOT KNOW THEIR STORIES NOR DO I KNOW WHO THEY WERE, EXCEPT FOR ONE STUDENT WHO TOLD ME IN 1994 THAT SHE HAD BEEN SEXUALLY ABUSED ALSO BY THE SAME PRIEST. THAT PERSON RECENTLY TOLD ME THAT A FEW YEARS AFTER SHE GRADUATED FROM THE BOARDING SCHOOL, SHE WENT TO THE SUPERIOR OF THE OBLATES OF MARY IMMACULATE AND TOLD HIM HER STORY. ALL HE COULD DO WAS APOLOGIZE PROFUSELY. SHE FOUND OUT MARCEL GENEUREUX WAS NO LONGER AN OBLATE (OMI), AND HE HAD BECOME A DIOCESAN PRIEST AND SERVED AS A PASTOR IN A NORTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE PARISH. I DO NOT KNOW IF HE WAS ASKED TO LEAVE THE OBLATES (OMI) OR IF HE LEFT ON HIS OWN TO BECOME A DIOCESAN PRIEST.

A FEW MONTHS AFTER MARCEL GENEUREUX WAS DISMISSED FROM HIS JOB AS CHAPLAIN, THE OBLATES OF MARY IMMACULATE WHO MAINTAINED A HEADQUARTERS JUST BEYOND THE BOARDING SCHOOL, ON LOWELL ROAD IN HUDSON, HAD INVITED ALL THE SISTERS AND STUDENTS FROM THE SCHOOL TO A VIEWING OF THE CHRISTMAS LIGHTS AND A HOLIDAY RECEPTION.

AT THIS RECEPTION, LO AND BEHOLD, APPEARS MARCEL GENEUREUX WHO CAME TO ME AND TOLD ME HE FOUND OUT THAT I ACCUSED HIM, AND THEN AND THERE, HE TOOK MY HAND AND BROKE MY WRIST. THE INFIRMARY SISTER AT THE BOARDING SCHOOL TOOK ME FOR MEDICAL CARE IN NASHUA. I TOLD HER A DIFFERENT STORY AS TO HOW I GOT HURT. I WAS IN A CAST FOR SEVERAL WEEKS.. AT THE TIME, I TOLD MY OLDER SISTER NOT TO SAY ANYTHING TO ANYONE AND ESPECIALLY NOT TO OUR

PARENTS. AS YOU CAN SEE, NOTHING HAPPENED TO THIS PERPETRATOR AS FAR AS BEING REPORTED TO THE LAW. I WAS UNDER THE DURESS OF HIS THREATS.

MY INTENTION FOR WRITING THIS LETTER IS TWO-FOLD:

1. MARCEL GENEUREUX'S NAME DESERVES TO BE ON THE LIST OF OTHER NEW HAMPSHIRE PRIEST SEX OFFENDERS. IF HE WAS BURIED WITH THE HONORS OF BEING A PASTOR AT HOWEVER-MANY CHURCHES IN NEW HAMPSHIRE, HIS NAME MUST NOW BE KNOWN INSTEAD AS A SEX OFFENDER, CHILD MOLESTER AND A CRIMINAL WHO HAS COMMITTED HEINOUS FELONIES. THERE CANNOT BE ANY OTHER DESCRIPTION OF HIM.
2. THIS LETTER IS HELPING ME COME FORWARD AND SPEAK TO THE RIGHT AUTHORITIES AND ENTITIES. I AM 62 YEARS OLD NOW AND HAVE BEEN ANGUISHED OVER THE YEARS FROM THIS ABUSE. I WAS TOLD TO FORGET AND FORGIVE BACK THEN.. THERE IS LITTLE SOLACE IN THOSE WORDS. IT IS MY HOPE THAT OTHER WOMEN WILL COME FORWARD. A REPORTER FROM WHR IN BOSTON COMMENTED THAT ONLY 5 % OF THE VICTIMS IN THE BOSTON ARCHDIOCESAN PRIEST ABUSE SCANDAL WERE WOMEN. THAT REPORTER, MONICA BRADY-MYERON, BELIEVED THE TRUE NUMBERS WOULD BE 50 % IF ALL THE WOMEN VICTIMS HAD BECOME VOCAL.

THIS LETTER IS NOT ABOUT SUING THE DIOCESE OF MANCHESTER. IT IS ABOUT EXPOSING SOMEONE WHO DESERVES TO BE REPORTED FOR A CRIME.

THE INFORMATION ABOUT MARCEL GENEUREUX NEEDS TO BE KNOWN. YES, I AM LATE IN REACTING TO THAT PREDATOR. HOWEVER, THE ON-GOING NEWS ABOUT THE SEXUAL ABUSE BY CLERGY IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH HAS AWAKENED ME FROM MY SILENCE. I RECENTLY HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH VICTIM ADVOCATES IN THE SPRINGFIELD MA AREA AND I AM BEGINNING TO WAKE UP FROM A TERRIBLE NIGHTMARE.

SHE ALSO EMAILED YOU IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM [REDACTED]

Here is a list of his assignments after he became a diocesan priest in 1959. I obtained the list from [REDACTED] whom you know. Please take note of the last paragraph she wrote.

I spoke with my sister today, and it is more accurate to make this correction: that in the fall of 1958 (instead of 1959) she revealed the abuse, and a few months later in December 1958 (instead of 1959), is when Genereux broke her wrist. I DO NOT KNOW IF HE WAS ASKED TO LEAVE THE OBLATES (OMI) OR IF HE LEFT ON HIS OWN TO BECOME A DIOCESAN PRIEST.

AT THIS RECEPTION, LO AND BEHOLD, APPEARS MARCEL GENEUREUX WHO CAME TO ME AND TOLD ME HE FOUND OUT THAT I ACCUSED HIM, AND THEN AND THERE, HE TOOK MY HAND AND BROKE MY WRIST. THE INFIRMARY SISTER AT THE BOARDING SCHOOL TOOK ME FOR MEDICAL CARE IN NASHUA. I TOLD HER A DIFFERENT STORY AS TO HOW I GOT HURT. I WAS IN A CAST FOR SEVERAL WEEKS.. AT THE TIME, I TOLD MY OLDER SISTER NOT TO SAY ANYTHING TO ANYONE AND ESPECIALLY NOT TO OUR

PARENTS. AS YOU CAN SEE, NOTHING HAPPENED TO THIS PERPETRATOR AS FAR AS BEING REPORTED TO THE LAW. I WAS UNDER THE DURESS OF HIS THREATS.

MY INTENTION FOR WRITING THIS LETTER IS TWO-FOLD:

THERE CANNOT BE ANY OTHER DESCRIPTION OF HIM.
2. THIS LETTER IS HELPING ME COME FORWARD AND SPEAK TO THE RIGHT AUTHORITIES AND ENTITIES. I AM 62 YEARS OLD NOW AND HAVE BEEN ANGUISHED OVER THE YEARS FROM THIS ABUSE. I WAS TOLD TO FORGET AND FORGIVE BACK THEN.. THERE IS LITTLE SOLACE IN THOSE WORDS. IT IS MY HOPE THAT OTHER WOMEN WILL COME FORWARD. A REPORTER FROM WHR IN BOSTON COMMENTED THAT ONLY 5 % OF THE VICTIMS IN THE BOSTON ARCHDIOCESAN PRIEST ABUSE SCANDAL WERE WOMEN. THAT REPORTER, MONICA BRADY-MYERON, BELIEVED THE TRUE NUMBERS WOULD BE 50 % IF ALL THE WOMEN VICTIMS HAD BECOME VOCAL.

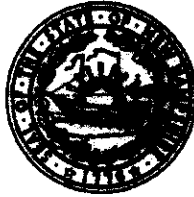

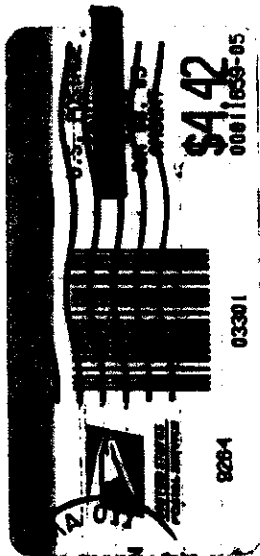
