They returned the computer to the Diocese and declined prosecution.

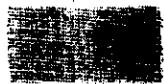

AL [redacted] [redacted] and spoke with Joe Naff at Diocese and he advised her to call me. Long story short the mother would come to NH with the children for the summer. They befriended this Fr. AL who subsequently mutually fondled/molested [redacted] at the age of 12 in 1970 while in NH. She has forgotten the last name. [redacted] does indicate that she spoke with a reporter at Concord Monitor who did article (?? Ann-Marie??) and they went through the list of AL [redacted]. [redacted] thought they determined who it was. [redacted] has not come out. She feels he has this repressed. He is a very unstable (threatens suicide) angry person. She feels it all stems back to the abuse. Told her not much we can do without the name to determine SOL etc. She was basically looking for him to get help. Advised her normally the help comes from Diocesan personnel who arrange therapy when a person comes forward and seeks assistance but not the reverse. Is this anything you want me to reach out for [redacted] She has given me his current address in [redacted] and name of his recent [redacted] along with their tel. #. She also feels that his sister a [redacted] of [redacted] would know the name of the priest.

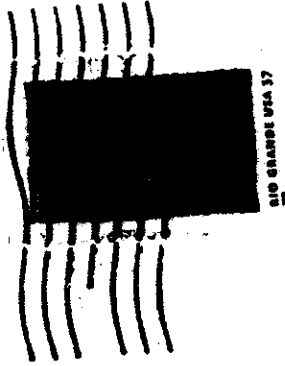

The authorities and he left the school after others came forth and exposed him.
I hope that others will benefit of this opportunity, It took me 8 years of intense
Therapy to function as a normal person.

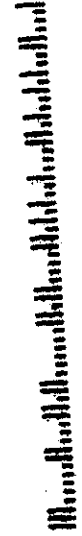

Message received on the voice mail of [REDACTED] - NH Catholic Charities, Nashua office on December 19, 2005 at 8:49 AM.

"This is [REDACTED] calling and I would like to report some abuse by Fr. Rusty. He used to be out of Our Lady of Mercy Church in Merrimack and that happened in the late 70's and early 80's and I've been working with [REDACTED] (social worker) at [REDACTED] to report this because there was some sexual abuse and molestation that was going on in my home when I was a child; he would come to my house and it's going on with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] through head games and abuse and they're holding Christmas presents back from me. I signed up for the Toys for Tots - the Christmas program and now they're refusing to deliver it and my car has been stolen and I have no money for Christmas and they were suppose to deliver my Christmas presents yesterday and today they're playing head games and are refusing to deliver the gifts etc. and they've done this to me before with food, etc. I'm really in a bad way and I need some assistance here and nobody's helping me and I really need some help. Could someone please get back to me as soon as possible I would appreciate it. My number is [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and I've been directed to report this to you guys and it's an emergency and I'd like to put some closure on what's happened with me with Fr. Rusty and it happened around the time of my First Communion and I think that was in 1980 with Fr. Rusty. So please call me back as soon as possible please. I'm [REDACTED] daughter and [REDACTED] daughter, who has past away, so please call me back as soon as possible - again [REDACTED] That was [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and I'm not sure what their last name is but they were supposed to deliver the presents yesterday, and today and they're still not doing that and there is going to be no Christmas for my children and I have no money and I'm having a very hard time and Fr. Rusty was going up my dress etc. and trying to give me presents to make up for it during Valentine's Day in the 80's around the time of my First Communion and I need this reported and taken care of right away and thank you very much. This is [REDACTED] - [REDACTED] is my date of birth and my phone number again is [REDACTED] - Bye"

Subject: Fr. Rusty

I talked to Quirk this morning. They made the connection between Fr. Rusty and Fr. George Roulier in the following way. There are no known priests in the Diocese named Fr. Rusty. Fr. Roulier was called Fr. Rusty. Fr. Roulier had faculties to work at Diocesan parishes and did fill in from time to time. They have no records of the parishes in which he filled in because it was just on a day-to-day basis. However, Fr. Roulier (aka Fr. Rusty) had 2 previous complaints (both reported to AGO). In one situation, the victim stated that Fr. Rusty was from the Sisters of Mary but was filling in in Nashua when the abuse occurred. Therefore, they know that this Fr. Rusty was most likely Fr. Roulier and by extension it is likely that the Fr. Rusty in the present complaint is the same perp. Since Fr. Roulier is dead and there are no other known Fr. Rusty's in the Diocese, I don't think there is anything else we can do to follow up.
