QUIRK advised that he has been retained by the Diocese of Manchester to be the liaison to make referrals and/or notifications to OAG.

QUIRK advised that they did not believe this needed to be referred but in spirit of cooperation are make notification.

That was assigned in Berlin/Littleton, NH area in the past. The Diocese received complaints about comments being made by the back in 2004 and pulled him out of service and placed on leave. (Received this information after asking QUIRK why id not show up on the roster I printed out of priest in SEP 04.)

QUIRK advised that was then assigned to the parish in Manchester known as Transfiguration (combined St. Edmunds and St. Jeans). Another issue came to light and was again relieved of duty. It was discovered on a computer at the Parish of Transfiguration that there were a number of homosexual adult porn photos. The Diocese had Jim LUNT (retired US Customs that worked computer porn cases) review the computer and he was able to determine that worked computer porn cases) review computer. They discovered 6,000 to 10,000 adult homosexual porn photos on the computer. The computer was referred to federal authorities for review and action. The Federal Agency reported back that they found a file with maybe 3-child porn photos but it was not clear if the statement accessed the file or if it was an attachment that he did not realize was there. They returned the computer to the Diocese and declined prosecution.

QUIRK advised that the Diocesan Review Board has reviewed the particulars and ruled:

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

The authorities and he left the school after others came forth and exposed him.
I hope that others will benefit of this opportunity, It took me 8 years of intence
Therapy to function as a normal person.

I talked to Quirk this morning. They made the connection between Fr. Rusty and Fr. George Routier in the following way. There are no known priests in the Diocese named Fr. Rusty. Fr. Routier was called Fr. Rusty. Fr. Routier had faculties to work at Diocesan parishes and did fill in from time to time. They have no records of the parishes in which he filled in because it was just on a day-to-day basis. However, Fr. Routier (aka Fr. Rusty) had 2 previous complaints (both reported to AGO). In one situation, the victim stated that Fr. Rusty was from the Sisters of Mary but was filling in in Nashua when the abuse occurred. Therefore, they know that this Fr. Rusty was most likely Fr. Routier and by extension it is likely that the Fr. Rusty in the present complaint is the same perp. Since Fr. Routier is dead and there are no other known Fr. Rusty's in the Diocese, I don't think there is anything else we can do to follow up.
