I write to provide you with an update concerning reports the Diocese received regarding allegations of sexual abuse by Fr. [REDACTED]. By way of background, on May 8, 2006 the Diocese notified the Attorney General's Office that it had received a report from [REDACTED] that Fr. [REDACTED] allegedly sexually assaulted her during the years of 1976-82; and then on May 10, 2006 the Diocese notified your office that it had received a report from Ms. [REDACTED] sister, [REDACTED] that Fr. [REDACTED] allegedly sexually assaulted her during the years of 1974-76. As you may recall, the allegations consisted of over the clothing sexual contact - Fr. [REDACTED] allegedly had them sit on his lap. Ms. [REDACTED] also made reference to a trip that she had taken with Fr. [REDACTED] to New York, but she was unable to recall any details of sexual conduct. On May 8, 2006, the Diocese placed Fr. [REDACTED] on precautionary administrative leave pending the outcome of the investigation. On July 13, 2006, the Diocesan Review Board ("DRB") met and based on the findings and conclusions of the investigation agreed that the allegations of sexual abuse by Fr. [REDACTED] were not probable. As a result, the DRB recommended that Bishop McCormack restore Fr. [REDACTED] back to ministry. Bishop McCormack accepted the recommendations of the DRB and the Delegate. Today, the Bishop met with Fr. [REDACTED] and restored him back to ministry. Fr. [REDACTED] will be available for pastoral assignments in parishes.

Please find attached a civil report relating to an allegation by [REDACTED] Ms. [REDACTED] alleges that, when she was a first grader at Holy Rosary School in Rochester in 1966-67, "Sister Mary Noel" touched her under her clothing. It was reported that the conduct occurred when the Sister was checking to see if [REDACTED] had wet herself. Ms. [REDACTED] reported that the accused was "Sister Mary Noel" of the Sisters of the Holy Cross. In light of this allegation, the Diocese reviewed personnel at Holy Rosary School during the time frame of the allegation and has identified a Sister Mary Noelle (birth name of Noelle Roy) who was a Sister of the Holy Cross who taught first grade at Holy Rosary School in Rochester in the mid-1960's. Sister Noelle died in 2001.

MEMORANDUM OF INTERVIEW

On Tuesday, November 21, 2006 at 0930 hours I went to the Pelham Police Department to meet with:

[REDACTED]

[REDACTED] reported he was an alter boy/parishoner at St. Patrick's Church in Pelham from 1970-1973 (dates are approximate) when he was a child and he was sexually assaulted by FATHER MAGUIRE. I explained to [REDACTED] that MAGUIRE was prosecuted for sexual assault and was incarcerated until his death last year.

[REDACTED] stated his family was heavily involved in the Church and MAGUIRE would take he and other alter boys to a private residence in Dracut, MA. He explained the structure was called Maguire Farm and it looked like a barn. He remembered the other boys' parents would pick them up but his mother encouraged [REDACTED] to stay at the farm with MAGUIRE. He additionally recalled other alter boys making comments such as "stay away from that queer" when referring to MAGUIRE.

[REDACTED] recalls being assaulted approximately once every couple months during a two to three year period. He specifically remembers being fondled at least two times at St Patrick's Church and he believes other alter boys and priests may have been aware and/or present. He said it was difficult for him to remember specific information about the assaults because he blocked them out of his memory.

[REDACTED] stated that on one occasion when he was at Maguire Farm MAGUIRE brought him upstairs and MAGUIRE had his arm around him and he

(MAGUIRE) yelled to some adults that were outside, "I've got a live one here." He did not know the identity of the adults that were present.

He also stated there appeared to be some tension at the Church between MAGUIRE and other priests and that shortly afterwards he somewhat abruptly went to a different parish and no one knew the reason.

██████████ did not disclose the abuse he endured until he was eighteen years old and decided to confide in his girlfriend. In approximately 1999-2000 when he heard about victims disclosing sexual abuse by priests on the news in Massachusetts he spoke with family members. ██████████ said he never directly disclosed to his mother but that she approached him to discuss the matter and he did not feel comfortable doing so, he believes she learned about the abuse through his relatives. At no time did ██████████ report the abuse to the Diocese.

██████████ expressed interest in counseling services and I stated I would have Sandra Matheson, Director of Victim/Witness Services look into the matter. I further explained that because MAGUIRE had been prosecuted and was deceased that the case was closed but that I would generate a report and he should contact me in the future should the need arise.
