## MEMORANDUM OF INTERVIEW

I received a notification from Atty. Quirk this date only indicating the name of [REDACTED] and the act taking place by Fr. Leo SHEA. Through Westlaw and DMV located and spoke with the following:

Ms. [REDACTED] verified that she is the one that notified Atty. [REDACTED] of the abuse by Fr. Shea. Requested further particulars in an effort to determine the elements etc.

[REDACTED] advised the acts took place between 1968 and 1973 when she was between the ages of 9 to 14. The perpetrator was Fr. Leo SHEA when he was assigned to the Holy Rosary Church in Plaistow, NH. The acts took place at the rectory and the church. [REDACTED] advised that SHEA had also victimized her stepsister. [REDACTED] that she has no idea where the stepsister is located or her current name.

[REDACTED] advised the acts consisted of touching over and under the clothing, French kissing, and licking her chest. She recalled an incident where she was sitting on his lap and felt that he had an erection but "he never pulled it out." She also advised that there was never any penetration.

A review of the SOL chart seems to indicate that SOL Expired.

[REDACTED] also advised that her stepfather was abusing her at the same time. She believes it was from 1968 to 1977 when she was ages 9 to 18. There was sexual intercourse involved and the stepfather was concerned about her getting pregnant. He is [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that she was [REDACTED] at one time and is aware of statutes of limitation and the fact that SOL does not run

it the person leaves the state. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] left the State of NH in 1980 and moved to CT and also winters in FL. [REDACTED] was a [REDACTED] at the time. She reported the incident to [REDACTED] and they had her speak with [REDACTED] at the time. [REDACTED] refused to go forward stating that no one would believe her.

Appears SOL may have tolled in 1980.

Dear County Attorney Reames:

Our office recently received a report of abuse involving a priest. I interviewed the victim and determined that there was also abuse by her stepfather.

I spoke with [REDACTED]

She advised that her stepfather, [REDACTED]

sexually abused her and her stepsister from 1968 to 1977. Ms. [REDACTED] advised that intercourse took place with her by [REDACTED]. She is not aware of the location or current name that her stepsister would be known as at this time. Ms. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] left the state of New Hampshire in 1980 and moved to Connecticut. CT DMV records had him at [REDACTED]. She also advised that [REDACTED] winters in Florida and records indicate that he is at [REDACTED].

Ms. [REDACTED] is a [REDACTED] therefore mentioned that the statute of limitations stopped running when [REDACTED] left the state of New Hampshire.

Ms. [REDACTED] advised that she did report the abuse to the Plaistow NH Police a number of years ago and they brought the matter to then County Attorney Eldridge. County Attorney

I just talked to Tom Hart from SCAO. They have closed all of the investigations against [REDACTED] (the allegations of sexual abuse [REDACTED]). Tom tried repeatedly to make contact with [REDACTED] (the guy who made the initial allegations). [REDACTED] initially refused to meet and then failed to appear for a couple of subsequent meetings. Tom then interviewed the alleged victim of the sexual abuse. The victim spoke very highly of [REDACTED] and denied that any misconduct occurred. Tom said the victim was nervous during the interview but did not give any indication that he had been sexually abused.

[REDACTED] then contacted the SCAO and agreed to a taped interview. [REDACTED] denied all of the allegations [REDACTED]. Tom Hart said there was nothing in [REDACTED] interview to provide evidence to proceed with further investigation.

The case is closed for lack of evidence.

Here is a summary of my phone conversation with Brian Quirk on 3/8/07 at approximately 1:45 p.m. about the allegations against Fr. [REDACTED]

Fr. [REDACTED] was a pastor at [REDACTED] between 2002 and 2004. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] He was a priest from the [REDACTED] to be a priest with the Diocese of Manchester were suspended in July 2004. It is believed that he now works at [REDACTED] helping them with their accreditation and as a crossing guard for some school in the [REDACTED] area.

The Diocese met with Jeff Mutter and Brad Gould at Dover PD [REDACTED] The Diocese investigator then met with [REDACTED] to try to convince him to report this information directly to the police. While Lundt was meeting with [REDACTED] disclosed that he was aware that [REDACTED] had anally raped a young boy between 2000 and 2003. [REDACTED] said that he learned that the victim of the rape had had a child with another girl in the parish. The girl had a still born child. [REDACTED] helped them get a burial plot for this still born baby. Thru burial records the Diocese was able to get what they believed to be the identity of the victim of the rape. I think Quirk gave me the victim's name but I don't have that information in my notes. The rape occurred either in [REDACTED]
