Attorney [REDACTED] reported that the accused is a Fr. [REDACTED]. As you will see from the attached report, the Diocese does not have a record of a Fr. [REDACTED] serving in the Diocese of Manchester. However, a Fr. 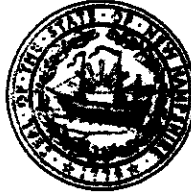


