Paul,

I write on behalf of the Diocese of Manchester to notify the Attorney General's Office of a report the Diocese received on March 4, 2008 regarding a deceased priest from the Missionary Oblate of Mary Immaculate in Washington, DC. This priest was not assigned to ministry in the Diocese of Manchester by the Bishop of Manchester, and therefore was not church personnel. Thus, my report is for informational purposes.

On March 4, 2008 Father Brian Silva, OMI of the Oblates in Washington called Joe Naff, Director of Clinical and Family Services at Hampshire Catholic Charities, stating that on February 25, 2008, a woman from [REDACTED] Hampshire, called the Oblate Shrine in Colebrook to report that her brother [REDACTED] had been [REDACTED] by an Oblate priest in Colebrook approximately forty years ago (in the mid-1960s) when her brother was [REDACTED] years old. Father Silva later told Father Arsenault the accused priest, Father George St. Jean, OMI, died in 1982.

Father Silva is seeking assistance in finding a therapist in the Plymouth area for Mr. [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] who presently resides in [REDACTED] area, also called the Oblates in Washington and on March 3, 2008, he met with an Oblate priest, Fr. [REDACTED] Aveques, OMI, who is currently assigned by his Provincial as the Director of the La Salette Shrine in Colebrook.

[REDACTED] Provincial placed him on a leave of absence pending an investigation. Bishop McCormack has withdrawn his faculties in New Hampshire pending the outcome of the investigation. The abuse by Fr. Birmingham occurred in the sacristy at St. James Church, in Fr. Birmingham's room at the rectory and in his car.

The abuse by Fr. [REDACTED] occurred in the sacristy at [REDACTED] in Gloucester, at [REDACTED] High School, two or three times on ski trips in New Hampshire and Maine, and once in his apartment in Beverly.

6. **Describe, in As Much Detail As You Can, the Nature of Abuse (Please use additional pages and attach them to this questionnaire, if necessary):**

In the sacristy, Fr. Birmingham would often hug me, pushing his entire body against mine, while kissing me on the lips. He would grope me over my clothes. When we were in the privacy of his room, and sometimes in his car, he would remove my clothing and masturbate me. He often forced me to reciprocate. He performed oral sex on me, and forced me to do the same on him. Numerous times he forcibly raped me, often times threatening me if I tried to resist. He also raped me digitally. When we were in his room, he often gave me alcohol to drink and showed me pornography.

Fr. Birmingham told me not to bother trying to tell anyone what he was doing to me because no one would believe me over him.

The abuse by Fr. [REDACTED] began in my freshman year at [REDACTED] High School in [REDACTED]. He was my English teacher. Fr. [REDACTED] would touch me over my clothes in the genital and buttocks area. He tried to get me to do the same to him. Then, on two

different ski trips, one to Conway, NH and the other to Maine, Fr. [REDACTED] got into bed naked with me while I was sleeping. He touched my genitals and buttocks with both his hands and his mouth. He tried to force me to do the same to him. I just laid there and did nothing. I was terrified.

The last incident occurred while I was living homeless in Salem, MA. He offered me a place to stay and food. I went to his apartment in [REDACTED]. After I went to sleep, again he was naked and climbed into bed with me. He tried to have anal sex with me; I pushed him off and grabbed my clothes. I ran to a friend's house (a woman I baby sat for). Her name is [REDACTED]. She called the Salem Police. I have not seen her in 35 years and I don't know what came of the report, but I never saw Fr. [REDACTED] again.

My mother sent me to Fr. Birmingham for counseling. I severed my relationship with her after the abuse. I dropped out of school and ran away from home. I have not been able to hold on to a job despite my education because of problems I have with authority figures. I am estranged from my only sibling. My marriage was very difficult because of my anger. I was afraid to have a child for fear that he or she would be abused.

I abused drugs and alcohol and often had thoughts of suicide. I mutilated myself by cutting for a long time. I feel a tremendous amount of shame, self pity and anger. I was afraid I would become an abuser.

It has been virtually impossible for me to establish or maintain a healthy relationship because of my feelings of detachment and my fear of intimacy. I can't trust anyone which means I have never had close friends. I am constantly fearful, which results in my avoiding crowds or public places. I experience flashbacks of the abuse both in my sleep and in my waking hours.

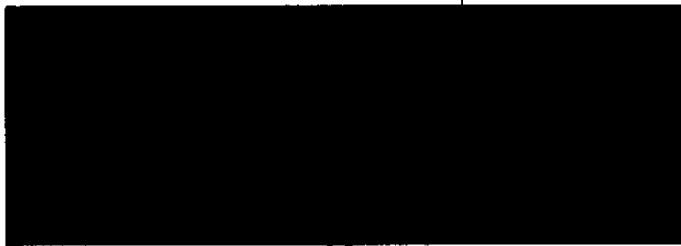
When I was approximately 14 years old, I underwent a court ordered psych evaluation at Salem Medical Center. I was inpatient at Northampton Hospital for a suicide attempt. In 1979 I sustained a laceration to my throat in a scuffle. I have been in the psychiatric unit at Concord, NH prison; I was treated at Lakes Regional Mental Health Center a number of times for cutting myself. I have been diagnosed with bipolar disorder and borderline personality disorder. I have treated with Dr. Carvalho, a psychiatrist at the Manchester VA Hospital. I was inpatient for mental health reasons at the Brockton VA Hospital from May to June, 2005. I was previously treated by Dr. Corman of the Bedford VA and am currently treating, on an outpatient basis, with Dr. Bobrin of the Bedford VA.

I have had numerous hospitalizations, many having to do with substance abuse and my mental health, including suicide attempts.

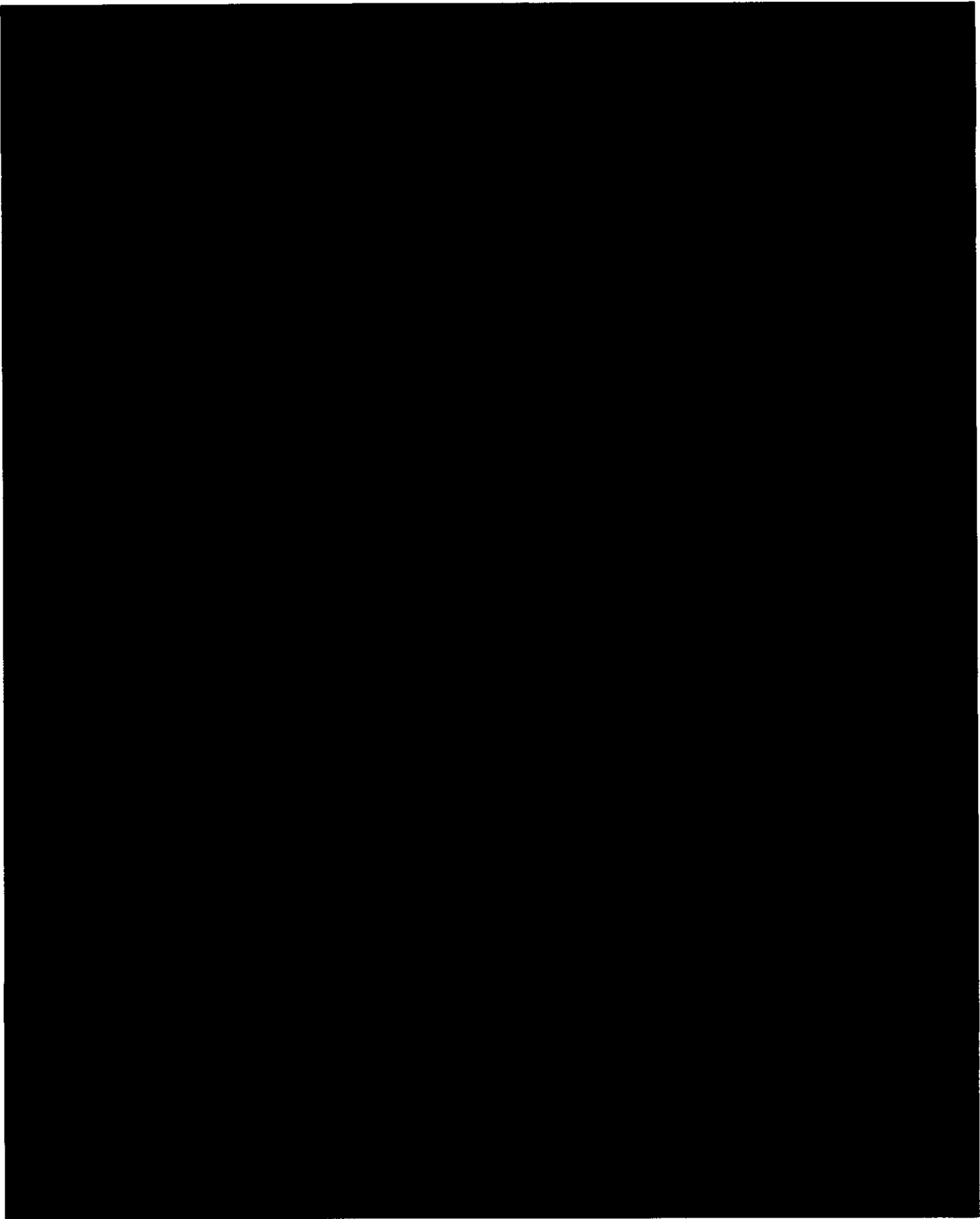

Just received a call from Atty. Brian Quirk. Background: 4/14/04 we received notification from Atty. Lamontagne that a complaint had been received from C.S.C. NH Diocese notified by Cong. of Holy Cross (CSC) because the act supposedly took place in [REDACTED] NH. At the time all they had was the name of [REDACTED] and the accused was a Rev. [REDACTED] C.S.C. I found tel. and address for [REDACTED] in MA. Acts supposedly took place in home owned by [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] NH. AG [REDACTED] had retired from MA and had been in NH for past 10+ years. 4/28/04 a letter was sent to [REDACTED] advising that the SOL had expired and to work with CSC for further counseling etc. Quirk advised that CSC hired James LUNT to review the complaint. LUNT determined that the allegations as presented could not have taken place. C.S.C. has re-instated [REDACTED] right to say Mass. [REDACTED] is currently 79 yrs. old and not assigned to a parish. Quirk believes he maybe used to say mass etc. but only as a fill in. Quirk advised that LUNT is available to be spoken with if we wished. Advised Quirk seeing the SOL had expired I did not see the need for OAG to have further involvement. Do you have a different opinion?

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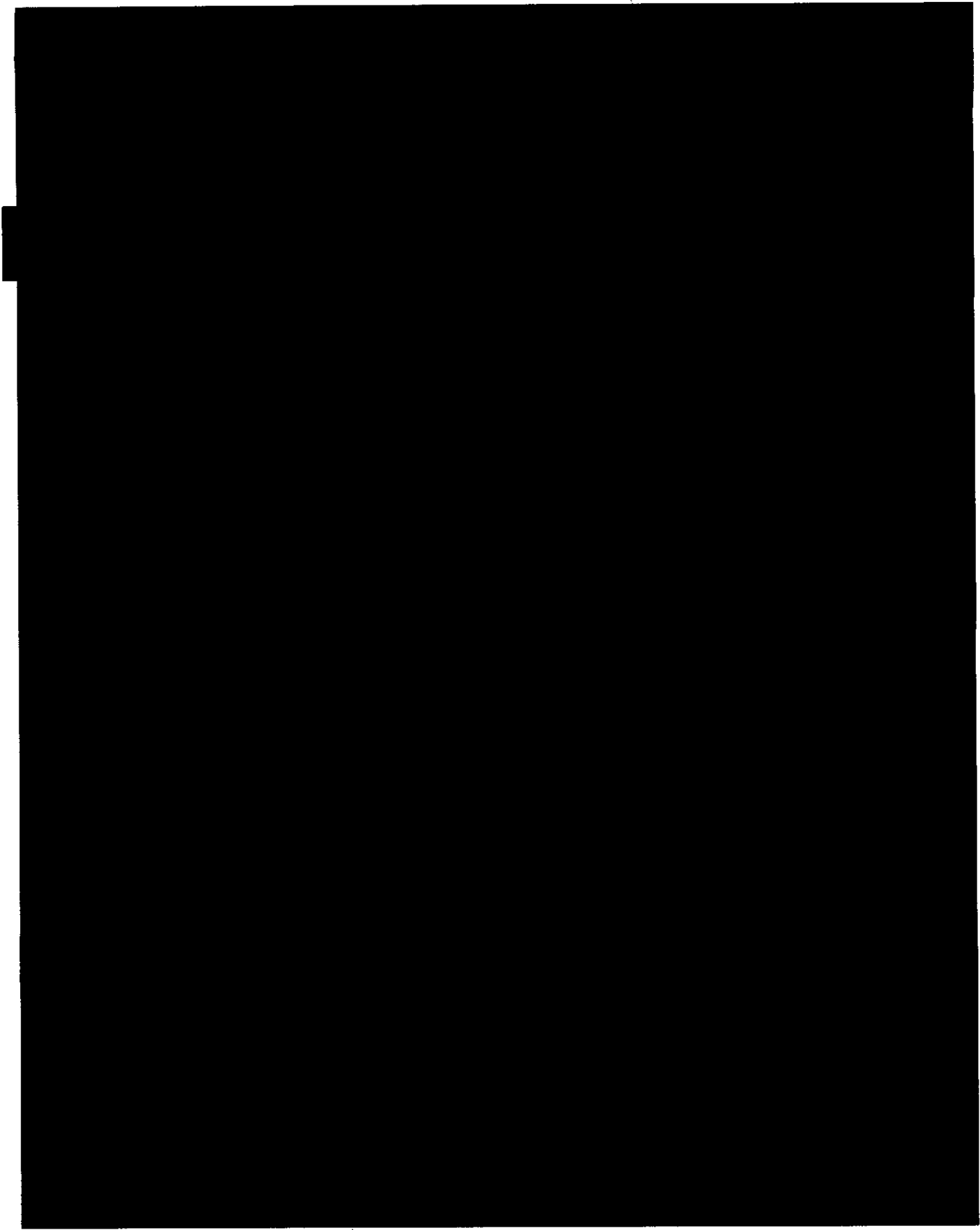

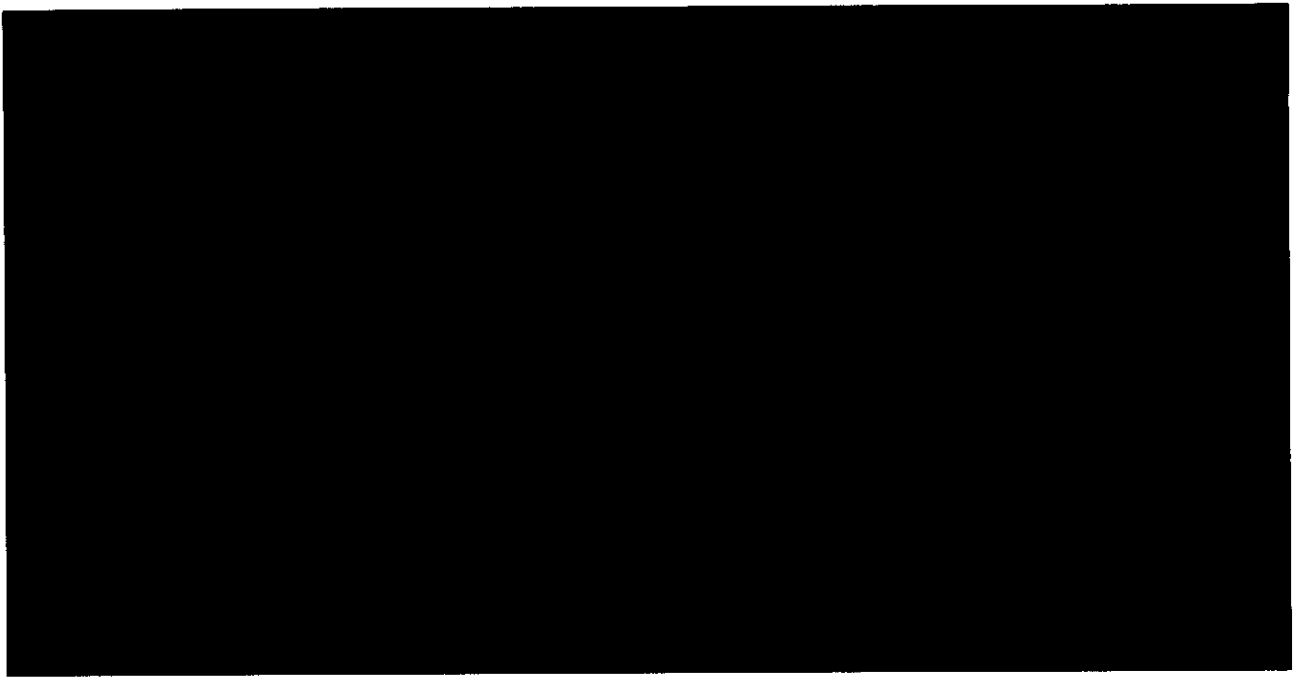

RE: Complaint Involving Fr. [REDACTED] C.S.C.

Thank you for speaking with me yesterday regarding this very sensitive and troublesome experience.

I submitted a memorandum to the Attorneys at my office and requested they review the particulars regarding the NH law on the statute of limitations.

I have been advised that in 1979 the acts in question would have been a felony with a six (6) year statute of limitations. The other factor is if an accused leaves the State of New Hampshire the statute tolls until their return. Everyone including yourself seem to be in agreement that Fr. [REDACTED] retired and returned to New Hampshire approximately ten years ago. Therefore the six (6) would now be expired. Moreover, even under the current law, the statute of limitations expired when you turned 40 years old.

I am sorry to advise you that that law enforcement cannot go forward with your complaint. I would suggest again as I did yesterday that you continue discussions with the Holy Cross Fathers in an effort to resolve your current concerns.

The statute of limitations has expired.

If this conduct was a felony AFSA (attempted forceable anal penetration), the statute of limitations would be 6 years in 1979. The statute of limitations would have expired in 1985. The statute of limitations was extended on Jan. 1, 1987. So, ordinarily it would have expired before it was extended. However, if the prep. did not move to NH until early 1990s then the statute of limitations would be tolled until he moved to the state. In 1990, the statute of limitations was extended to 22 years past the victim's 18 birthday (in other words the crime must be charged before the victim turns 40). The victim turned 40 in 2002, so even if you could take advantage of the current statute of limitations, it has expired.

Hi Jim: I had left a message with [REDACTED] on 4/21 but he had not called back. 1107 hrs. this date called and he answered the phone. Advised had not made prior reports. Briefly spoke with Essex DAs office 1 yr ago but had not given details.

[REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED] advised was in 9th grade 14 - 15 yrs. of age and was recruited to participate in a play, West Side Story, at the high school. [REDACTED] was in charge of the Drama Dept. [REDACTED] had a tough family life and [REDACTED] played the supporting role if he needed anything etc. [REDACTED] advised he ran away from home Thanksgiving day 1978 (16 yoa) and [REDACTED] took him in at the [REDACTED] residence [REDACTED] MA.

The residence in NH belonged to the brother of [REDACTED]. The brother died and Fr. [REDACTED] took over the residence at [REDACTED] NH. [REDACTED] believes the incidents in NH took place early 1979 prior to his 17th birthday. Acts had taken place in MA prior but in NH Fr. [REDACTED] advised during this time he would keep to himself and [REDACTED] approached him and advised if he needed anything that he would assist. [REDACTED] would speak with him, take to the movies, out to eat etc.

[REDACTED] advised on Thanksgiving Day 1978 (he was 16 yoa) he ran away from home. Fr. [REDACTED] took him in and he resided with [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] MA until he was 18. [REDACTED] then went to college and would return to the residence of [REDACTED] through vacations in college.

In the sacristy, Fr. Birmingham would often hug me, pushing his entire body against mine, while kissing me on the lips. He would grope me over my clothes. When we were in the privacy of his room, and sometimes in his car, he would remove my clothing and masturbate me. He often forced me to reciprocate. He performed oral sex on me, and forced me to do the same on him. Numerous times he forcibly raped me, often times threatening me if I tried to resist. He also raped me digitally. When we were in his room, he often gave me alcohol to drink and showed me pornography.

Fr. Birmingham told me not to bother trying to tell anyone what he was doing to me because no one would believe me over him.

The abuse by Fr. [REDACTED] began in my freshman year at [REDACTED] High School in [REDACTED]. He was my English teacher. Fr. [REDACTED] would touch me over my clothes in the genital and buttocks area. He tried to get me to do the same to him. Then, on two

different ski trips, one to Conway, NH and the other to Maine, Fr. [REDACTED] got into bed naked with me while I was sleeping. He touched my genitals and buttocks with both his hands and his mouth. He tried to force me to do the same to him. I just laid there and did nothing. I was terrified.

The last incident occurred while I was living homeless in Salem, MA. He offered me a place to stay and food. I went to his apartment in [REDACTED]. After I went to sleep, again he was naked and climbed into bed with me. He tried to have anal sex with me; I pushed him off and grabbed my clothes. I ran to a friend's house (a woman I baby sat for). Her name is [REDACTED]. She called the Salem Police. I have not seen her in 35 years and I don't know what came of the report, but I never saw Fr. [REDACTED] again.

My mother sent me to Fr. Birmingham for counseling. I severed my relationship with her after the abuse. I dropped out of school and ran away from home. I have not been able to hold on to a job despite my education because of problems I have with authority figures. I am estranged from my only sibling. My marriage was very difficult because of my anger. I was afraid to have a child for fear that he or she would be abused.

I abused drugs and alcohol and often had thoughts of suicide. I mutilated myself by cutting for a long time. I feel a tremendous amount of shame, self pity and anger. I was afraid I would become an abuser.

It has been virtually impossible for me to establish or maintain a healthy relationship because of my feelings of detachment and my fear of intimacy. I can't trust anyone which means I have never had close friends. I am constantly fearful, which results in my avoiding crowds or public places. I experience flashbacks of the abuse both in my sleep and in my waking hours.


When I was approximately 14 years old, I underwent a court ordered psych evaluation at Salem Medical Center. I was inpatient at Northampton Hospital for a suicide attempt. In 1979 I sustained a laceration to my throat in a scuffle. I have been in the psychiatric unit at Concord, NH prison; I was treated at Lakes Regional Mental Health Center a number of times for cutting myself. I have been diagnosed with bipolar disorder and borderline personality disorder. I have treated with Dr. Carvalho, a psychiatrist at the Manchester VA Hospital. I was inpatient for mental health reasons at the Brockton VA Hospital from May to June, 2005. I was previously treated by Dr. Corman of the Bedford VA and am currently treating, on an outpatient basis, with Dr. Bobrin of the Bedford VA.
