Thank you for speaking with me earlier this week regarding. This Office recently received an allegation of sexual abuse against Mr. This Office requested to remain anonymous. She alleged that between 1975 and 1978, when she was between the ages of 13 and 16 years old, she was involved in an extensive sexual relationship with Mr. The time, Mr. The was a Deacon with the Diocese of Manchester. He was working at St. Anthony's in Manchester, New Hampshire. When she made the allegation, the complainant shared certain personal details that she learned from Mr. The during the course of their relationship. Those details are consistent with information that the State learned during its recent investigation of the Diocese of Manchester.

The State believes that this matter falls outside of the statute of limitations for purposes of criminal prosecution. Accordingly, the State does not intend to pursue a prosecution in this matter.

The information received by the State is a complaint of wrong-doing, Mr. has not been formally accused of a crime by this Office, and the complaint has not been established by any standard of proof.

However, we received a similar allegation of wrong-doing against December.
