Dear Paul:

This is a different kind of report about which I thought you should be made aware.

Fr. Donald Clinton, Pastor of St. John the Baptist Parish in Suncook, was made aware of the arrest recently of a 16 year old boy, [REDACTED] for sexually assaulting two minor children who were in his care when he babysat them. The assault charges and the relationship between [REDACTED] and the minors are unrelated to the Church. The minors are not Parishioners at St. John's.

[REDACTED], however, is an altar boy and has trained altar servers at St. John's. In light of this, I expect that [REDACTED] will be removed from his role as altar server as well as trainer.

Specific Concerns: The parents of [REDACTED] informed Fr. Clinton on 5/15/04 that their son was arrested for sexual assault of the above noted girls. Reportedly, [REDACTED] was the childrens' babysitter. [REDACTED] is a 16 y/o who trains altar servers at St. John the Baptist Church in Suncook, NH. He and his family are parishioners of this parish. The names of the complainants are unknown and Fr. Clinton reported that they are not parishioners of the parish. The incident is unrelated to church ministry. Fr. Clinton reported that [REDACTED] was to be served papers (relative to his arrest) on 5/17/04. I have called Fr. Clinton to determine which police department is investigating. I am waiting for his return call.
