I just called the cell phone of [REDACTED]. He just called me back. He advised that [REDACTED] had to resign because of a conflict. He is now represented by Atty. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised his DOB is [REDACTED]. He believes the act took place in 1978 or 1979 at the age of 15 or 16 when he was a Freshman or Sophomore at West HS. The act is that Petit performed oral sex on [REDACTED] and requested like wise. [REDACTED] indicated there was some oral contact but he did not qualify it as oral sex. Looking at the schematic it appears [REDACTED] would have been 18 on 12/27/81 well prior to the controlling date of 4/27/84.
