I am in receipt of the fully executed reconciliation report for the period of April 1, 2006 through June 30, 2006. This confirms that all reports of sexual abuse of a minor by Church personnel received by the Diocese of Manchester and forwarded to your office have been reconciled for that period.

With respect to the reconciliation report for the period of January 1, 2006 through March 31, 2006, reports concerning [REDACTED] (report date of 3/8/06) and employees at Bishop Brady High School (report date of 3/31/06) were not included on this form. The reconciliation report is generated to ensure that all reports of sexual abuse of a minor by Church personnel that are received by the Diocese of Manchester have been forwarded by the Diocese to the Attorney General's Office in accordance with the December 2002 agreement. As we discussed, the reports concerning Mr. [REDACTED] and the employees of Bishop Brady High School did not relate to sexual abuse of a minor. Thus, those reports were not included on the reconciliation report.
