who the Diocese suspected was the source of the anonymous complaint. Jim Lundt interviewed denied authoring the letter or having any knowledge of inappropriate behavior with children by Fr. Lundt has other complaint letters authored by and believes that based on these other letters, is still likely the author of the anonymous complaint.

The anonymous complaint was sent to Fr. parish and he received it. Fr. was the person who notified the Diocese of the complaint. Fr. has no involvement with the boy scouts besides the fact that they use a room in the parish where he is the priest.

Based on this, the Diocese is taking the position that the complaint has no semblence of truth and does not intend to put Fr. on leave. I agreed with this in light of the lack of any specific additional information to investigate. I told Brian to update me if they learned any new information.
