Kindly accept this letter as our formal claim for compensation for sexual abuse suffered by the letter at the hands of Father Ed Richards, a catholic priest incardinated in the Diocese of Manchester.
Mr. sis a resident of New Hampshire.

Following high school he did earn an associates degree in business management from the NH Vocational Technical College in Nashua in 1997. He has been employed as a vith the since 2001 and has been a full time with that for the last two and one-half (2-1/2) years.

When he was a child, he and his family attended St. Patrick's Church in Milford. He was not a particularly church oriented child, and recalls that when St. John Neumann was built in Merrimack it was basically structured as a giant recreation hall with metal chairs and was stark. He describes the facility as not as "churchy" as other churches and as a result both he and his parents thought that he would be more comfortable there and would

attend church more regularly. At the time, Father Ed Richards was assigned to St. John Neumann.

Prior to as well as after the family moved to St. John Neumann did begin to attend CCD classes. In addition, Father Richards ingratiated himself to family and social life and in fact would have dinner with the family at their house almost on a weekly basis during this period of time.

The sexual abuse began after he was signed up for along with twenty (20) other boys scouts to earn a rather prestigious religious award which recalls is the highest religious award given in the Boys Scouts of America Organization. Apparently this was a two (2) year program which involved religious instruction in a CCD format. The classes for this program were actually conducted at the private homes of the boys involved. The recalls that the program started with twenty (20) boys scouts and by the end the number had decreased to about six (6).


Toward the end of that two (2) year program Father Ed Richards suggested to the remaining boys, including that they take some type of trip together. There was originally talk about going to the Caribbean Island of St. Maarten. As it turned out, the trip was ultimately planned for Disney World in Orlando Florida. Prior to that trip, however, recalls two (2) other trips where Father Ed brought several of the boys remaining in the boy scout program.

The first trip, while the boys were still in their classes, was to a condominium up north. The condominium was rented and the group was suppose to go skiing. He recalls being around 12 or 13 years old at the time. Father Ed was alone with the group of boys on this trip.

The second trip was to long beach island New Jersey. The family of one of the boys in the group customarily rented property there and that is where the group took this particular trip. Again, a recalls the boys and Father Ed Richards staying up late, drinking wine coolers that he provided, watching pornography, and talking about sex. At the time, the boys were young teenagers and thought Father Ed was very "cool" in that he allowed them to engage in activities such as drinking, watching pornography and discussing sex which they would not obviously do with their parents knowledge or in their parents' presence. Again, on this second trip, no sexual contact took place between Father Ed and

Due to this other boy essentially disclosing what had happened to the entire group, the four (4) and Father Richards got together and held a form of a "meeting" at a picnic table in the campground. It was at that time that Father Richards apologized and told the boys that while he was asleep he was dreaming of petting his dog, Sam and that is how he came to having contact with and masturbating the boys. He promised he would get help and counseling and that this would never happen again. He further claimed that he didn't even know that it was happening at the time. He implored the boys not to tell anyone and again promised that it would never happen again. The recalls Richards specifically threatening him telling him that he knows things about him that he had heard in confession and that he had better not disclose what had happened to his parents or to anyone else or he would get in trouble and Richards would tell his parents the things that had confided in him in confession.

The group eventually left Disney World and it is recollection that no sexual contact occurred on the way back.

Approximately two (2) months after this Disney World trip along with the other boy who was abused decided to quit the boys scouts. It was at that time that and this other boy began various forms of acting out including shoplifting and smoking marijuana. He recalls that the other two (2) boys that were on the trip did not begin to exhibit these anti-social type behaviors.

The sexual abuse has had a significant impact on throughout the course of his life. He is unable to attend church nor do his parents since he disclosed to them back in 1996 the abuse he sustained. He also has had significant and at times overwhelming guilt at not having immediately disclosed what Richards had done and perhaps save subsequent boys from falling victim to Richards sexual predilections. In addition, it is belief that this sexual abuse committed by Richards was the direct cause of him quitting boys scouts and civil air partrol and he began to engage in antisocial and criminal behavior as a teenager including the instances of shoplifting and his use of drugs at an early age which drove an abnormally large wedge between him and his parents.

Will obviously be available to discuss this matter further including but not limited to the significant negative impact that this abuse has had on him since it occurred through the present.

When you have had an opportunity to review this letter please give me a call to advise as to when the customary interview will be conducted.




