JUDGMENT OF COURT	

7/2/73. Criminal Complaint filed. Case called at 11:15 a.m. Plaintiff appeared by James LaPointe, District atty. Defendant appeared in person and by Atty. Charles Polidori, 2922 W. Forest Home Ave. Milwaukee, WI Phone number 672-0100. Complaint read. Attorney for defendant presented statement to the court. Court advised defendant of maximum penalty in this matter. Matter returnable on July 16, 1973 at 8:30 a.m. for either setting date for preliminary or waiving preliminary. Atty. for defendant waived the statutory time for holding the preliminary. Defendant released on his own recognizance.

July 16, 1973. Case called at 10:27 a.m. Plaintiff appeared by Joseph McCormack, assistant to the district attorney. Defendant appeared in court in person and by Attorney Charles Polidori. Defendant's father also appeared. Defendant waived the preliminary hearing. Information filed with the court. Defendant waived the reading of the information. Defendant entered a plea of guilty. The court advised defendant of the maximum penalty if found guilty of such crime. The court questioned the defendant. The court will accept defendant's plea. Mr. McCormack and Mr. Polidori presented statements to the court. The court will withhold imposing any penalty at this time and ordered that a pre-sentence investigation be held. The court set this matter for sentencing on Monday, August 13, 1973 at 4:00 p.m.

August 13, 1973. Case called at 4:00 p.m. Plaintiff appeared by James M. LaPointe, District Attorney. Defendant appeared in court in person and by his attorney Charles Polidori. Mr. Robert Rathburn probation agent appeared in person. Mr. LaPointe presented a motion to the court to amend the complaint to allege the maximum penalty provided for this violation, to-wit: maximum penalty of not more than five (5) years imprisonment or not more than \$500.00 fine or both. Motion granted by the court. Mr. LaPointe recommends a term of 5 years be imposed and sentence stayed and be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years. Mr. Polidori presents a statement to the court. The court places defendant on probation for a period of three (3) years and defendant is to continue his program with Dr. Graham.
