Your letter of Dec 4, 2001 took me completely by surprise. After the happenings of the past several years, I would think the church hierarchy would understand the damage done to individuals at the hands of some priests but obviously they still don't get it. Initially when I met with Sr. Catherine Mulkenin at St. Theresa's Rectory in Billerica, I asked for advice & signed form stating I wouldn't bring suit or ask for monetary compensation for the years of molestation by Fr. Sidney H. Sawyer starting when I was 6 or 7. This was about healing, not money. I was assured the Church would pay for any & all therapies however long the process took. Dr. Kaclemas & I have been conservative & cut back as I progressed. I now feel like the rug has been pulled out from under making this very important sounding

so-called "Internal Investigation
Review Committee". Please
they to judge if a man I am
able to be discharged. I don't
drive one hour each way
in all kinds of weather to
sit- chat with the doctor. It's
very stressful but helpful.

I strongly suggest the
"Committee" review & reconsider
their action.
