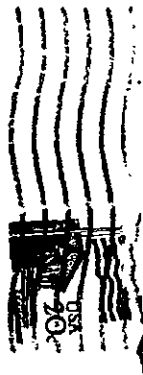
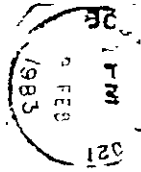
There now - two things both to "warm" the heart & to improve the stance (I didn't even ask you to sing for me.)
