I have not seen you people for many years, but time still goes on. I am now over 75 years old and am retired in the Parish where I live. I do very little active ministry. I am here because of my age and physical condition. I had a heart attack a few years ago - 5 hours

of severe chest pains with difficulty in breathing. I was told that I could have another at any time. So I live one day at a time and do my best. From my father I inherited sugar diabetes. For over 5 years now I take a daily dose of insulin with the needle. I have difficulty walking also as the arteries in both legs are completely blocked up. My memory is very poor.
