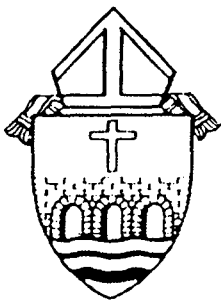

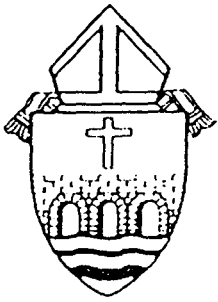

On Thursday, December 24, 1992, shortly before 5:00 p.m., I telephoned Dr. Richard Bridburg, a psychiatrist on the staff of the Institute of Living in Hartford, who evaluated Father Pcolka in 1989 at our request, after we received the first report of the accusation of Mr. James Krug concerning Father Pcolka, and informed him that Mr. Krug himself has now come forward with a much more detailed set of accusations.

Dr. Bridburg indicated that he would look up the evaluation he did three years ago and discuss it further with me on Tuesday, December 29, 1992.

This morning, I talked with Dr. Bridburg on the telephone and he reviewed with me his evaluation of three years ago, and asked me to call him back after my meeting with Father Pcolka which will take place this afternoon at 3:30 p.m., in the presence of our diocesan legal counsel, Atty. E. Terry Durant.
