Attempts were made to contact Mr. Courtney at his residence however it was learned that he was out of town for the weekend. His Attorney Rembert Ryals, phone 946-6181, has contacted the Othello Police department on 4-28-86 in reference to setti up a meeting with this officer and Mr. Courtney to discuss this matter. An attempt to get a statement from Mr. Courtney will be made and also a permission for taking a polygraph will be asked to see if we can obtain this information. - RR/ Could I just ask you, is this transcribed, and if so, would we get a copy or do you just ship the tape over to Miller and let him listen to it?
- JD/ Well, what we do is, I do the tape interview and have it transcribed by one of our secretaries into a form there and then I just . . . she uses my initials when I talk on the tape we ask Ed his name and he verifies who he is sp she can distinguish his voice, your voice, and my voice on the tape. She will use his initials for what he says when we transcribe it and then he can read it after we're done transcribing it to make sure that it is all correct, that there isn't anything added to the statement that he doesn't want in there. - JD/ Ed, this is an interview in reference to an allegation that an has made against you through the Child Protective Service. It happened on Saturday, the 19th of April, 1986. What I would like you to do is basically just tell me in your own words what happened that day if you can.
- EC/ Would it be appropriate, I would like to give some background information.
- JD/ That's fine. In your own words just explain, however you want to tell it.
 If you want to add a little bit before and then just go ahead and work your way up into what happened that day.
- EC/ Right. I'd appreciate that. I think that it gives a little bit better understanding of the whole picture. And is a 7th grader at our school, and I've had several, I don't know if you'd say run-ins, or occasions at which I had to correct for behavior in school. not a student in my class, but even so, rowdiness in the halls with other students, on one occasion just

before this whole thing happened, running down the hall. I guess I should say was going down the hall to a sutstitute teacher's classroom, running back as slamming the door shut and then running to classroom. And I happened to be come back and go in and apologize to the teacher. Fighting coming by and made with the other kids, things like that. The . . one of the situations, or one of the, I guess you would call it horseplay, maybe, but I had a little different. connotation. There were several occasions in which either be outside my classroom or maybe in or around the locker room area, something like that, like a baseball coach would do, well, not would do, but we've seen it happen, I should say, and, major league ball kind of be grabbing genitals and that type of thought it was kind of humerous. I frowned on it, in fact on one occasion I mentionned to ___it was inappropriate and that stopped. I don't know, you know, I'm just saying that these are the kinds of associations that I had prior to baseball season. The week of March 10th . signed up on the list in the office for baseball, to play 7th grade baseball. And, um, then on March 17th we held our first meeting and wasn't there at the first turn out. I'm kind of responsible for both the 7th and 8th grade keeping a roll call because they're required to attend ten practices before they can play in any games. And, um, didn't show up until I guess the 7th day of practice, which was as I recall about the 26th of March, I think it was, looking through the dates. Um, just to give a time frame of where we're coming from. In the meantime had, um, I guess talked to , who is the head coach of the program. He's specifically the 8th grade coach, and, uh, instead of coming to me. I assumed that was probably because we didn't get along too well, or perceived I'd been after on a few occasions and preferred to go to instead. So, outlined for that would have to be at every practice without missing a single one, that ... attitude would have to improve, that it was generally felt that had a rather poor attitude in general, and that there would be no clowning around, those kinds of things. Anyway, set down some himself told me that this was the way it would have standards for as Well, I guess the very next day, which was the 27th, . was suspended to be. from something, I can't remember, it didn't deal with me. I don't recall exactly what it was, but was suspended from school so that violated the terms of that right away. And the kids on the team asked, and I said, well, can't make up the practices that needs to make now so off the team. Um, we had spring break that following week, the first week of April, and then the next week went would kind of pass me, there were a couple of occasions, maybe by and, um, and in the hall or something, looking kind of sheepishly. And I can't recall the date, it was near the end, I believe, of that week, the second week of April,

where we did get into a conversation and I said, "Well, I know you've got some baseball talent" because I'd seen him play in the All Stars up at Moses Lake last year, the Little League All Stars. And, um, told me how important baseball was to and I said, "Well, it's too bad because outlined these terms for you and, uh, you violated the terms of the outline." And at that point denied any knowledge of any terms. said that did not give

any terms about practice and so on, what I had just mentionned here. So I went to and said, you know, well, still wants to play. I think we should do something about it. I can't recall the actual words, but in effect, that's what it was. said to me, "Do you really want him?" And I hesitated, there's no doubt or question in my mind that no I didn't really need to have a possible problem on the team. And, uh, already it seemed like whatever was being set up wasn't being followed through on. But at the same time I felt that, well,

obviously already down on me so I would like this decision on the problem to come from lap, not from any decision or judgment that I made. meaning

the kid. So I outlined right there are some dates that would have to make up to come to practice in order to get ten days in before, and my target date was April 29th, the JV game against Kittitas. Now, I would explain why that was. We have situations where we have varsity and JV games combined and the kids who aren't quite as talented as the other ones play in the JV games. We have other separate varsity games where a full top varsity team will play in two different leagues. Any on May 1st, which is coming up, we have a varsity game against Connell, and that's the next to the last one. May 13th is another varsity game against Prosser and that's the end of the season. So in order to get those, in order for to play in a varsity game, would have to show something in a JV game. I just couldn't move in on a roster, even if was better than the others, without some justification. So that's why we set it up at that. time. And, um, so that was, I guess we're talking, I believe around the 15th or 16th of April. Uh, was the time of the conversation now that I set up these And, uh, in order to do that, as a matter of fact, I included dates for to practice about 45 minutes to an hour in the afternoon before allowing ball games, our home ball games, which are scheduled for 4:00. In other words, could count that as a practice. That's not a normal situation, but, uh, I allowed for that. Well, the next, uh, well, on the 16th, I guess, the time I was talking to must have been a few days before, because on the 16th of April, who is one of the teachers there, came and said, "Is

on the team?" And I said, yes. said, well owed me these detention times and these things are piling up and if hasn't had them made up by the end of this week, then at the end of the week there's more time added on.

So, the 17th we had a game, and J said, all right, tomorrow and Friday, uh, you make up those times, get it all wiped out and then for next week, and I had an extra day built in there, uh, on this list. Uh, so would be able still to fit into this time line to get ready for the 29th. Uh, time on the 17th and then was absent from school on the 18th. And I subsequently found out there was some kind of an altercation off grounds, a fight or something, I don't know what it was. And I found out there was some kind of repair, had to visit the doctor, dentist, or whatever it was for that so there was a problem again on the times, not having times made up. Um, I thought, well, what other alternative is there now at this point. That's probably it, and yet I was not reluctant, willing rather, I guess common sense would have said, well that's it, forget about it. And I still felt that this should come from should be able to say, I violated those terms and I can't make it and I'll play Babe Ruth ball and worry about playing 8th grade ball next year. And I said, now, the only other alternative I had, I was going to be away the following week in Yakima and so on the 19th, Saturday, sometimes we've had practice if somebody needed one. We counted it, it wasn't really a had done this too, previously. That we could have it, spend the time, and this is the day that we're talking about, the 19th. There, you could have a session and call it as a practice. Well, I didn't, I came up to school on the morning of the 19th, and I guess about 10:00 in the morning, or something. I had a, uh, double header to umpire in Warden at 1:00 that afternoon. And it was kind of showering a little bit. I talked with one of the , uh, one of our faculty members and I got into a conversatio that lasted a little bit longer than just say hello and talk and that. I thought, well, it's kind of showering out, I probably should bag that idea. I intended to call and ask wanted to come up and count that as a day. Well, I decided i f to go ahead and call and, uh, I said, at least if not home or doesn't want to come then accepted that responsibility and I'm not going to worry about it at that point. was interested or anxious to come up said, yes, and, uh, and get in a practice. So I told that I'd either be down at the office or my classroom, I was making out a test. And a little while later, I don't recall exactly what hour it was, I suppose it was probably in the neighborhood of 11:00, uh, there was a knock at the door outside of my, the outside door of the end of the wing there, was there. So [said, hold on let me do something for just a minute here. I said, no, I guess I can finish this up later, let's go and so we went over to the locker room. Um, I got out a fungo bat, and a couple of leather balls and then I decided to get the rubber ball, because prefers us to use that when it's wet out. It doesn't make the leather

balls as soggy, the covers soggy. And I couldn't find the rubber ball or rubber baseball. So I went over to the coaches room, and was actually in the storeroom with me and then came into the coaches room. Uh, sometimes baseball equipment is left in there, gloves or caps or whatever, on the, on the shelf there in the coaches room. So, um, I don't know, um, previously to this I don't even recall what the conversation was or anything of that type, but it was, um, I guess you might say friendly, but not anything in particular of kidding around or that. I was trying to be as casual as I could, uh, I think, really what I was trying to do is to insist, or make sure that the feeling that I perceived that had that I was after for these altercations or whatever wasn't, you know, this was baseball and I wasn't going to hold that against

could do the job that's fine, and that I had nothing personal against

Uh, so, I said, you know, had been on the wrestling team and and I had weighed in the kids before each event for meets and that and had been on the wrestling team, and right there in the coaches room is where, and there was a scale there. And it was kind of obvious that was putting on some pounds and this isn't too good for baseball, especially for running and that, so while I was looking for the rubber ball I told get on, why don't you get on the scale there and see what you weight. Do you know how much you weigh? It looks like you put on some weight. And did. got on there, um, and I said, well, what's the weight like? said I've put on about five pounds. And, um, then I kidded, I said sounds like a lot of home cooking. Well, at that time I didn't find the rubber baseball in there and

was just standing there and I took my two hands up on the shoulder muscles, I call those the teacher's muscles, right here. And this is not uncommon for me. but I, saying that in a kidding context about home cooking, and I said you know, was talking about the extra weight and that and I, so I went like that with the muscles kind of backed in . . . I hit the counter with something like about this and kind of, you know, went back. Actually at that point I was leaning on Um, it wasn't that was really trying to get away or anything, you know, it wasn't hurting that much, a pretty good sized kid. I wasn't hurting of nor was I attempting to. Really, this, that is not unusual for me probably, or for some of the other coaches, uh, I suppose, what I would classify as horseplay. Um, I think at the lower levels, and Scootney and that, we put the younger kids, fact I remember was kind of, I don't know, hug or whatever you do, you know, the kids, and it's kind of a good relationship and you get in junior high and it's obviously different from that, it's a lot more along the lines of horseplay and that, which is, has always been my style, it's, uh, kind of establishing a rapport with the kids. So, and, I was putting down on the bench, right off the, I don't know if you've been in the locker room there, the bench is right outside the, you know, the kid's benches where they change. And, um, it actually, it wasn't having the effect that I thought would, you know, a smile or laugh or retaliate or whatever the situation was, it, the whole, whole tone, even from the beginning was, um, I guess you might say; serious or non-joking or whatever, I don't know, if really tired, or what it was but it obviously wasn't accomplishing what I intended, I don't know what I intended, but you know, I mean I wasn't even really thinking, wasn't planning, uh, plan of attack to make

And at that point, that's the day after practice, I still didn't see any problem. I didn't experience any problem with reaction, or, you know, it was just a brief conversation at that. - EC/ Well, I was just going to say at that meeting then is when was over there, and then when they closed the door and sat down I thought "Boy, that's unusual." And that's when they brought it up to me. They said something about Saturday, and I said, you know, I said Saturday, I told them this happened, including the other thing. I think they said there was a complaint about a student on Saturday or something like that. I think was the only student I saw, and that was the first I knew of any follow up problem. That's . . . OK. . . all I wanted to say.
- RR/ If you have any questions, of course.
- JD/ That's, I think you've pretty well covered over what, the day.
- EC/ I realize that was lengthy and I thought if I had just mentioned Saturday by itself, um, I don't think it made a whole lot of sense. Or at least I, I think it's important that I My reaction was that, um, well, I'm not sure if this . . . you know, My reaction was that it was an attempt to get after me. I guess that's one way to say it. I find it difficult to . . without getting inside somebody's head, to judge why they do or say what they do or say. Um . . but I wouldn't . . . I can't see how it's possible or the individual, the student sincerely feels . . and I don't know. I haven't talked to you people have. That this is really a situation where I . . I made any kind of sexual advances, or whatever the allegations are.
- JD/ That's, is that all of your statement there?
- EC/ Yes, that's it.
- JD/ Uh, you are aware of what a polygraph is?
- EC/ I've seen it on TV.
- JD/ OK, would you be willing to take one if we could set it up here in the near future?
- RR/ Well, I'm going to have to interrupt now. He will put out the statement if you want. He'll rely on my advice.
