Pr. Smilanic verbally provided the following information on his discussion with the former Rev. When a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago, Fr. was assigned for a period of time to Five Holy Martyrs with Pr. Przybylo. Fr. Smilanic reported that Mr. Was assigned to the following:

- Fr. Przybyło was known as "Chester the Molester" by the police officers in the neighborhood
- Whon assigned to Five Holy Martyrs, there was an occasion when the then Fr. walked by Pr. Przybylo's room and saw a boy in only his underwear sitting on the cloric's floor; Pr. Extraction of Bishop Abramowicz who responded by telling him that the boy was Fr. Przybylo's "...personal altar server..."

Ms. McCluskey shared the information with the Board members that Pr. Przybyło's current whereabouts are not known.

In an 8-0 vote in light of the information presented, the Review Board determined that there is reasonable cause to suspect that the alleged misconduct occurred. The Board also made the following recommendations:

- That a notice of these proceedings be sent to the Diocese of Joliet, to the bishop of the diocese that Fr. Przybylo was ordained for, and to the bishop of the diocese that he was subsequently incardinated into
- That Fr. Przybylo's name he placed on the warning list that is circulated throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago on a regular basis by the Office for Canonical Services
