3. During my sophomore year at Regina, I was summoned to Father Soens' office.

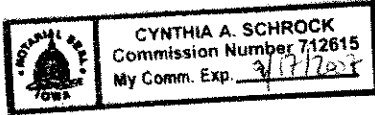
4. I was afraid to go to Father Soens' office because I had heard stories from other boys of what Father Soens did to them when he called them into his office.
