19 that that would be wrongful conduct? 20 A. Yes. Q. You would think that was wrongful conduct for 24 a religion teacher and a priest to do that while you 25 63 1 were at Regina, wouldn't you? 2 A. Yes. 14 If a 15 priest in confession hears that a minor is being abused 16 by a priest, is the priest that hears the confession under any responsibility to do anything about that? 17 A. Well, I think he has to advise that penitent 18 19 to address the situation. 20 Q. And how -- how would you think would be an appropriate way to advise a minor that was being 22 sexually molested by a priest that he should address 23 that situation? A. Probably give him the information of to whom 24 25 he should take this complaint. 64 Q. And that would be some civil authority or someone else that it should be reported to? 2 A. Civil authority, yes. 3 Q. And do you believe that's the proper practice 5 of a priest in the confessional, to give that type of advice in the confession, along with any type of Hail 7 Marys and that type of thing? A. Yeah, it seems to me this would be the kind 8 9 of advice you would want to give. 10 Q. And that's because it's important to try and correct any instances of sexual misconduct by a priest 11 with an underaged minor, correct? 12 13 A. Correct, or anyone else. 14 15 16 17 18 Q. But also the advice as to how to address it
