Your Excellency -

Father Edward Paquette has asked me to send you a report. I have very little to report actually. I have seen him several times. He is not concerned with the psychological aspect of his problem of homosexuality (which remains unchanged). He sees his situation exclusively as being on probation because of ~~offenses~~ he committed. Since (according to his accounts to me) he has not been involved in further offenses he sees no reason for further "probation" and is most eager to ~~be~~ be permitted to accept an offer to assist in a Florida parish. Apparently his family ~~is~~ quite disturbed about his predicament and he naturally would welcome relief from this.

Since he has not entered into any real treatment situation with me his going to Florida would not involve the loss of psychological help from me. Whether there is danger still of further offenses I cannot say. It isn't possible for me to say that there is no risk. God bless you
