This letter is pursuant to the policy of the Diocese of Joliet to inform the State's Attorney of allegations of sexual abuse by one of its clergy or other personnel.

On January 23, 2006 you were notified of the first allegation against Father Burnett by a [REDACTED]

Thereafter on August 7, 2006 you were notified again that there was a second individual by the name of [REDACTED] who also accused Father Burnett of sexually abusing him when he was a minor.

The purpose of this letter is to report that a third individual by the name of [REDACTED] has also accused Father Burnett of sexually abusing him in the early 1970's when he was a minor.

Mr. [REDACTED] has requested that his name not be released to the public.
