"I.... firmly hold and accept each and every definition of the unerring teaching of the Church, with all she has maintained and declared, but especially those points of doctrine which expressly combat the errors of our time. In the first place I profess my belief that God, the beginning and end of all, can be certainly known and therefore proved to exist by the natural light of reason from the things that are made, that is, from the visible works of the creation as a cause from its effects. Next I recognize and acknowledge the external arguments of revelation, that is, divine facts, especially miracles and prophecies, as most certain signs of the divine origin of the Christian religion, and I hold that these are altogether suited to the understanding of every age and of all men, also of our times. Thirdly, I likewise hold with firm faith that the Church, the guardian and exponent of the revealed Word, was proximately and directly founded by the true and historic Christ Himself, while He dwelt amongst us, and that she was also built upon Peter, the Prince of the Apostolic Hierarchy, and upon his successors to the end of time. Fourthly, I sincerely accept the teaching of faith as transmitted down to us from the Apostles through the orthodox Fathers in the same sense and even in the same wording; and, therefore, I wholly reject the heretical notions of the evolution of dogmas, which pass from one sense to another alien to that which the Church held from the start; and I likewise condemn every error whereby is substituted for the divine deposit, entrusted by Christ to His Spouse and by Her to be faithfully guarded, a philosophic system or the creation of a human consciousness, gradually refined by the striving of men and finally to be perfected hereafter by indefinite progress. Fifthly, I hold for certain and sincerely profess that Faith is not a blind religious sense making its way out of the hidden regions of the sub-liminal consciousness. morally tinged by the influence of heart and will, but is a true assent of the intellect to truth received from without by hearing, an assent whereby we believe to be true, because of the authority of the all-true God, whatever by the personal God, our Creator and Lord, has been spoken, testified and revealed.

"I further, with all due reverence, submit and with my whole mind adhere to all the condemnations, declarations, and ordinances contained in the Encyclical letter *Pascendi* and in the Decree *Lamentabili*, particularly regarding what is called the history of Dogma.

"I also reject the error of those who aver that the Faith proposed by the Church may be in conflict with history, and that Catholic dogmas in the sense in which they are now understood cannot be harmonized with the more truthful "origins" of Christianity. Moreover, I condemn and reject the opinion which declares that a Christian man of better culture can assume a dual personality, one as a believer and another as an historian, as if it were permissible for the historian to hold fast what his faith as a believer contradicts, or to lay down premises from which there follows the falsity or the uncertainty of dogmas, provided only that these are not directly denied. Likewise I reject that method of estimating and interpreting Holy Writ, which, setting aside the Church's tradition and the analogy of Faith and the rules of the Apostolic See, adopts the rationalists' principles and with equal arbitrariness and rashness considers criticism of the text the one only supreme rule. Furthermore, I re-ject the opinion of those who hold that a teacher of the science of Historical Theology or the writer on the subject must first put aside the notions previously conceived about the supernatural origin of Catholic tradition or about the divine aid promised for the perpetual preservation of each revealed truth; then, that the writings of individual Fathers must be interpreted solely by the data of science, without any reference to sacred authority, and with that freedom of judgment wherewith every profane record is usually examined.

"Finally and in general, I declare myself to be far removed from the error of the modernists who hold that in sacred tradition there is nothing inherently divine; or who-far worse stilladmit it in a pantheistic sense; so that thus there would remain only a bare simple fact equal to the ordinary facts of history, viz., that the school started by Christ and His Apostles finds, in the ages that follow, men to carry it on by their energy, their skill, and their genius. Wherefore most firmly do retain and to my last breath will I retain the Faith of the Fathers of the Church concerning the sure endowment of truth, which

All this I promise that I will faithfully, entirely and sincerely keep and inviolably guard, and from this never in teaching or howsoever by word or writing in the least depart. So I promise, so I swear, so help me God and these His holy Gospels.

Reverend and dear Father:

By means of this letter I want to give you a more formal and complete reply to the inquiry you made of me on Tuesday, 31 January, 1967.

If you wish to learn a little of my background, may I suggest that you read the article, "The Night Before Ordination," which appeared in the 29th of April, 1966, issue of <u>The Tidings</u>. At La Purisima, Our Lady of the Rosary of Talpa, and Santa Isabel I was in direct contact with Fathers Agustin Montoya, Jose Cervera, C.M., and Michael G. Sheahan. These priests taught me with their daily living what a <u>Pastor</u> of souls must be. These priests sacrificed themselves for their people.

Here, at St. Thomas, I have tried to put what I learned from them into practice. Although I have not always been successful, I have tried to do my best in performing my duties. I am young and still have very much to learn, but I think that the people of St. Thomas are the better judges as to whether or not I have been serving God and them.

I have been very happy with the people I am serving here. They are a lovable people, and I love them. My love for them is returned a hundredfold.

My "unhappiness", if any and if you wish to call it that, has resulted only since you came to our parish. My greatest displeasure is over the way you have been mistreating and hurting so many of our people.

Your recent actions regarding our Confraternity of Christian Doctrine has pushed some highly qualified lay persons out of the work that is properly theirs. "The Confraternity is made up of Active and Associate members. The first of these are the men,

women, and youth of a parish who are willing to take an active part in the work of the Confraternity..." True, the laity work "under the supervision of the parish priest," but because of your actions we have lost a highly qualified president and some very good teachers. Although I obey your orders in regard to my teaching the fourth grade of the Saturday CCD, I object to and protest your actions because some of the members of the CCD were insulted and hurt by you.

I have also been saddened by the unfortunate resignations of the president, secretary, and treasurer of the Guadalupe Society. I object to the way you have mistreated the Guadalupanas. The officers have resigned because you have made conditions for them very difficult to bear.

Also, according to what you told the Guadalupanas' former president: that the other assistant's Mass schedule could not be interrupted; that he started the Society; that he has seniority over me; since you, as pastor, are chaplain or spiritual director of every St. Thomas' society; and since I should have nothing to do with the election of new officers; etc., I bow to your wishes and let you know that I have nothing more to do with the Society. The Guadalupanas are now completely in your hands; again, I obey what seem to be your wishes expressed to the former president.

Accordingly, I will give you the guadalupanas' materials and, as of my last day with the Society, 22 January, 1967, this was the Society's financial status:

Since October the Guadalupe Society has helped the parish with well over four hundred dollars in addition to the priceless contributions of their time and work for a variety of projects. But, you have hurt quite a number of the members with your constant requests regarding their money. Now, you are completely in charge of them.

There have been some other persons who have quit the jobs they had in the parish. You hurt their feelings. I can assure y

you that there will be more persons quitting jobs and resigning positions-as long as you continue hurting them.

Some of the Spanish-speaking people of the parish have expressed to me their feeling that you are prejudiced against us Latins, the majority of your people! Your remarks about "your people," "you Latins," "you Mexicans," " your kind," etc., which you have spoken from time to time, are hurting and insulting.

I also voice my objection to the regimentation and "police state" methods you are employing to force the parish children to be present at Mass on Sunday. I object to your using the children to spy on each other. Although the children and their parents fear voicing their objections to you, they have made their disgust with your methods known to me.

As pastor, you have every right to run our parish as you deem best. However, there is more and more opposition to your manners being voiced. I find it very difficult to explain to the people that you have "good" reasons for the changes you have made and for the way you conduct your self with them. All I can say is, "he's the boss; what he says goes!"

There has also been much complaining about your weekly stress on money, envelopes, children's envelopes, dollar-a-month club, etc. Some of the parishioners have told me that they simply will stop coming to St. Thomas and will attend other parishes.

Money seems to be constantly on your mind. This is offensive to the poor people of the parish. With all the money talk, you have been very reluctant to provide the CCD with funds for their needs: catechisms, paper, visual aids, film strips, etc., so I have had to pay for these items from my own money and that of another priest from outside our parish.

Also, I think that most altar boys have at sometime or another eaten some of the altar breads for Mass. Yet, you made a federal case out of the "disappearance" of three large hosts. You blamed me for this and then rationed out the hosts to me-three large hosts for six masses! So, in order to avoid trouble with you, I was forced to get and pay for the hosts that I use for Masses at St. Thomas.

On the other hand, "the sky's the limit," when you entertain. All the banquets you have been holding for your friends seem to have no financial limit. The limit, if any, for your banquets is that the assistant(s) eat in the kitchen, eat early, or eat out! The few weeks that Monsignor O'Dwyer was here and up until the time you came this rectory was the priests' house. It has since turned into something of a restaurant for you and your friends.

Again, this is your house and you see the policies here. But you even insulted my family one of the few times they came to visit me. Now, in order not to offend you I simply greet them in the sacristy or on the sidewalk.

Shortly after you arrived in the parish, you told me to tell the parish societies to hold a velcoming reception for you. With great difficulty we managed to organize-on short notice-a small, but sincere welcome for you. Afterwards in your room you told me that "there wasn't an intellectual in that bunch" of people who gave the welcoming speeches. This constant insistence of yours on the lack of "intellectuals" in our parish is hurting the people who hear you state it. Our people are poor, hard working and they readily admit the fact that they have not received a high level of education. They know it! So, why do you keep insisting and rubbing it in that there are no "intellectuals" around here?

Last Sunday, very briefly I am told, from the pulpit you publicly ridiculed Father DuBay. Our own Cardinal-Archbishop has had the charity to restrain from that! Yet, you use the pulpit to ridicule a fellow-priest, rather than use the time to instruct the people.

You have told some of the parishieners that I don't do my parish duties. They have told me what you have said. I admit the fact that I don't do all of them! But, the records show that, since my arrival in the parish on 14 May, 1966: out of 45 weddings to date, I have handled 29 completely and the preparations for 8 others, a total of 37; out of 35 funeral services. I have had 16; out of 147 baptisms, I have performed 86 of them. No records are kept on the number of confessions, but you be the judge as to who hears most confessions of the Spanish-speaking adults and children and of the school children. On First Fridays I have 25-30 Communion calls. Etc. This is the work I was ordained to do and I am very happy doing it to the best of my poor ability. I don't shy away from my priestly work, I welcome iti

I am not afraid to work, and under a good boss and good working conditions I can only do my best! My former bosses can tell you how well or badly I worked for them: Mr. Tony Cirone of San Jose; the Sisters of the Holy Family and the Sisters of Bethany in East Los Angeles; Monsignor Kevin Keane at the minor and major seminaries; Fathers James Hansen and William Ready, C.M., at the minor seminary; Father F. David Pansini, C.M., and Sister Ruth, I.H.M., at the Seminary College Library; and Mr. Jerome Stehly of Lilac. They can tell you whether or not I worked well for them! They were excellent bosses who were kind and understanding.

Sometimes even on my "day off" you give me work to do, but I don't mind doing it. I am used to doing hard work and I have been

doing my best at it.

I admit the fact that I have failed you in regard to the servers. Perhaps you are right about my having used "bad psychology" on them. However, I can't see the benefit of ruling them with fear. Many of the servers don't come when they know that you are the celebrant. When you ask for servers for your late Masses, they tell me that they prefer to go to class rather than serve your Masses. This is the result of your fear tactics. Of course, this does not excuse me for not teaching them their responses.

At the school you keep bothering the sisters! It is a difficult task to get and keep the children's attention, but you think nothing of interrupting classes with complete disregand for the students and sisters. If the sisters express their justified dislike about what you do, it is because you provoke them. Tes, you can complain to the chancery, the chancery complains to their superior, and the superior reprimands the guilty sisters. Tet, you are the one who provokes the disrespect that you receive.

You had been here only a short time and trouble resulted with the sisters living next to the church. In all the years past there had been no trouble with past pastors, assistants, and residents-including one of our auxiliary bishops. But, when you came there was trouble!

I was told that at a recent meeting you told the people pree sent that the priests were here to serve the people of the parish. You told them that you were effecting the wishes of the people. However, they complained that "he didn't even bother asking us what we wanted."

I think that there is something definitely wrong when you don't realize that you are hurting many of our people by what you say and do.

You asked me an honest and sincere question about my happinness or unhappiness here at St. Thomas. This letter is my honest and sincere answer to that question. As you told me, you are the pastor and your policies are the rule of the parish. I agree with you! Although I do not agree with many of your policies, I have tried to obey you to the best of my poor ability. And I will continue to do so.

I repeat, I am very happy serving the people of this parish. My unhappiness, if any, is over the fact that you are hurting so many people. Perhaps you don't realize it!

I figure that they should know that-as Monsignor Hawkes told us at the seminary-6-"your first parish is your first love." I love the people of this parish and I will continue to serve them as long as my superiors order me to do so.

If you do not want me to remain in your parish, I think that our superiors should be notified of that fact. But, I do wish to remain here!

Again, this letter is my honest and sincere answer to the questions you asked me last Tuesday. I am acting of my own free will and no one else is involved with me in writing this letter. I fully accept any favorable or unfavorable consequences arising from this action which is entirely my own doing.

I wish only the best for you, for the people of our parish, and, yes, even for myself.

My original intention in getting a Folk Mass started in St. Thomas was to interest the young men and women who attend High School and College in coming to Church. I was primarily interested in the Middle, and Late Teens. This age group I felt could be attracted to such a Mass. Because of the large number of Latin Bands in our neighborhood, I felt that this innovation would be worthwhile. I asked Father Ramos to implement it at the 5:30 p.m. Sunday Mass.

Well, the Folk Mass was started with high hopes and great expectations. Unfortunately, the support of the middle and late Teens did not materialise. There was only one guitarist and the group of about 20 was mainly constituted of girls of 13 and 14 years of age. Within a month, I was told that the emerging Teens were not showing up. The late hour was blamed for its untimely end.

Then I was informed that a morning Mass would be best, preferably the 11:00 a.m. Since this Mass was already well attended this would be impossible. A possibility that I did not exclude was the 9:45 a.m. Mass which had been converted into a Vernacular High Mass this Fall.

To forestall further failure, I insisted that before we resume the Folk Mass again, we should have a trial period. We arranged to hold an additional 9:45 a.m. Mass in the St. Thomas School Auditorium thru the month of December. In this way, I wished to find out if it would arouse the sustained interest of our young people.

Throughout this experimental period, the constant complaint was that the attendance was small and unpunctual. In addition, the overwhelming majority were children from our Grammar School. Very few High School or should I say Junior High - 9th graders - attended and never on time. These belonged to a club called The Internationals which comprised for the most part last year's eighth grade from St. Thomas. Even this group did not attend regularly; in fact 12, would have been a high average.

In the circumstances, I did not think that the initiation of a Folk Mass at 9:45 a.m. would be justified at this time. Those children who attended were faithful Church-goers. The average attendance of 40 children in the auditorium did not warrant an additional Mass. Personally, I would prefer to see those children attend Mass with their parents as a family unit.

I have not excluded the possibility of a Folk Mass at 9:45 a.m. This will depend on the grass roots support it will receive from the middle and later Teens. I do expect more than a dozen freshmen regulars who, with one or two exceptions attend Catholic High School, to justify this venture. It is possible that the majority of High School and College students who attend Church do not think it is such a good idea. Let's hear from the silent majority. f

We are sorry that you felt our entire A9 class and student body, many of whom no doubt are parishoners of yours, should be punished for the actions of a few. We regret also that you did not notify us when the insidents you describe first began to occur. We would have veloced an opportunity to work with you in an attempt to stop the harrassment you and your students have suffered.

We have started an investigation into the incidents mentioned and already have been partially successful. We would appreciate any specific information which would help us identify any of our students. You may be sure we will take the necessary disciplinary action.

Our students understandably were upset by your charges and have requested permission to work on the problem. For the past several days our Student Council has been trying to contact you with an apology on hehalf of Berendo students and an invitation. Our Student Human Relations Club has some interesting plans which may alleviate our mutual problem to some extent.

We plan also to invite you to our next School Community Relations Committee meeting. Many Berendo parents have joined with us in an effort to help.

Please be assured that the staff and student body of Berendo are concerned about its community. We stand ready to help work out the problems which face us all.

# Summary of Interview with REDACTED

On Monday, February 23, 2004 REDACTED came to the Diocesan Pastoral Center at 6:15PM for a personal interview with Msgr. Gerard Lopez and Sister Rosaline O'Connor, Victim Assistance Coordinator.

REDACTED is a resident of the Diocese of REDACTED and a parishioner of St. Bernardine Parish, San Bernardino. He was born on REDACTED 1973. Currently his contact information is as follows: REDACTED REDACTED (cellular).

REDACTED stated that he wished to make a complaint of sexual misconduct against Reverend Eleuterio Victor Ramos.

REDACTED stated that he was sexually abused and molested by Father Ramos on various occasions from 1983 to 1989. The following are the locations of these incidents: a mountain cabin in Crestline, CA, San Bernardino County (3 or 4 times); at a hotel near Disneyland in Orange County; at a hotel near Universal Studios in Los Angeles County; various times in the city of Tijuana. The abuse started when REDACTED was about 10 to 11 years old in 1983; the abuse ended when he was about 16 years old in 1989 when he and his family moved from Tijuana to the city of San Bernardino.

REDACTED said that to his knowledge Fr. Ramos now lives as a retired priest in the Long Beach area and that Fr. Ramos has had severe health problems (diabetes and a kidney transplant).

to describe how he met Fr. Ramos. REDACTED I askedREDACTED stated that he and his family lived in the Tijuana area. They met Fr. Ramos when he was working at Divina Providencia Parish and Our Lady of Loreto chapel in Tijuana sometime in 1983. REDACTED was an altar boy at the time\_REDACTED stated that Fr. Ramos would tell the family that he had worked in the La Habra area before coming to Tijuana and that he was receiving financial payments from the Los Angeles Archdiocese. REDACTED REDACTED stated that Fr. Ramos never did minister in the San Bernardino Diocese. REDACTED also explained that Fr. Ramos was born in the United States and was of Hispanic background; this clarified Fr. Ramos' nationality since it was assumed that Fr. Ramos was a Mexican national.

#### REDACTED

was very distraught and emotionally upset when describing his complaint. He did not go into many details of the type of abuse he sustained because of the embarrassment of the situation. However, he did state that Fr. Ramos would perform sexual acts and acts of sexual These acts were never mutual since REDACTED molestation toward REDACTED REDACTED said that he himself never was required to perform any sexual acts toward Fr. Ramos. These acts took place on the many trips that Fr. Ramos took with REDACTED when the latter was an altar boy in Tijuana. would accompany Fr. Ramos on these trips for the most **OnlyREDACTED** part; there were a few trips when several altar boys would accompany Fr. Ramos and REDACTED to the Crestline mountain cabin.REDACTED also said that Fr. Ramos bought many gifts for all of the altar boys from the Tijuana parish and chapel. REDACTED received many personal gifts from Fr. Ramos.

REDACTED is bearing the burden of having to conceal his victimization. In December 2003 his family saw a case of child abuse against Fr. Ramos in the newspaper; this was a case in the Orange County area, Since Fr. Ramos and the REDACTED was a very close friend of REDACTED family. REDACTED s mother and sister asked him if Fr. Ramos had ever molested him. REDACTED denied any form of abuse out of embarrassment. When the Los Angeles Archdiocese recently published the names of priest abusers, his mother and wife saw Fr. Ramos' name listed. When his mother and wife once again asked if Fr. Ramos had ever abused him sexually, REDACTED once again said "No." However, he did let his family know that he was very saddened by these allegations against Fr. Ramos whom REDACTED considers a good family friend.

Over the years, REDACTED has had to deal with the destructive effects of his alleged abuse by Fr. Ramos. In recent years, REDACTED has found himself withdrawing from his parish ministries. He is thinking of resigning from all of his ministries. He does not feel that he is leading a spiritual life. He feels that he must constantly hide his abuse from his closest family members, especially his wife. At this point of the interview, Sister O'Connor provided guidance to REDACTED on the pain he feels from having to conceal his abuse from his wife. REDACTED is also fearful of his mother's reaction to his abuse since he recalls that his mother would frequently encourage her son to take private overnight trips with Fr. Ramos (e.g., the Crestline, Disneyland, and Universal Studios trips). REDACTED last had communication with Fr. Ramos in 2002. REDACTED is not angry with Fr. Ramos, although REDACTED feels that Fr. Ramos should be held accountable for his actions; REDACTED believes strongly that Fr. Ramos needs to be judged. REDACTED states that he is in a very good marriage with 2 children REDACTED

REDACTED). He did express a fear that he too might someday be an abuser since he had heard that victims of abuse automatically become abusers. REDACTED said that although he has helped coordinate the altar servers at his parish, he has asked other adults to never leave him alone with the altar servers. Sister O'Connor assured REDACTED that it is not the case that victims of abuse automatically become child abusers. REDACTED does not wish any harm to Fr. Ramos; REDACTED stated that he still considers Fr. Ramos as a "second father" who showed him many good things in life and helped him to see many places in the California area which he otherwise would not have seen growing up in Tijuana.

REDACTED wishes to find out as much information on Fr. Ramos as possible. For example, was Fr. Ramos transferred to Tijuana because of his past abusive history in the Los Angeles Archdiocese? To this day, REDACTED REDACTED still thinks that any priest he sees at a parish is a child molester. He continues to live with this fear. He finds it hard to trust priests.

I assured REDACTED that the following would be done: 1) a police report would be filed on his behalf; 2) I would contact Sister Sheila McNiff at the Los Angeles Archdiocese to report his complaint; 3) I would also request information on Fr. Ramos on behalf of REDACTED Sister O'Connor assured REDACTED that she would work with Sister Sheila McNiff in terms of coordinating his pastoral care and counseling. Sister O'Connor also offered pastoral care to REDACTED his wife, and his mother if she ever needed such pastoral care. REDACTED was very appreciative of this offer of pastoral assistance.

I asked REDACTED if he knew of other victims of Fr. Ramos. REDACTED stated that he did not know of any other children or minors who had been victimized by Fr. Ramos. I also asked REDACTED for his last known address for Fr. Ramos in the Long Beach area; he said that he would try to find the letter he had received from Fr. Ramos which contained this address; REDACTED stated that he would call me to give me this address.

The interview concluded at 8:20PM.
