
Unfortunately, he has had a hard time in adjusting to seminary life, especially his transfer from St. Meinrad's to St. Mary's in Cincinnati.

Daniel was somewhat discouraged during the past scholastic year, even though he tried hard. He has been encouraged, however, by the faculty to return to St. Mary's this year.

Personally, I believe that he has many good talents. He meets people well, he is concerned, he is involved and he is interested.

I stressed that he must apply himself fully and completely during this year. It is my hope that he is successful.
