SEMINAR OVERVIEW

Healing The Wounds

Sexual Addiction in the Church

"Healing The Wounds" is designed for clergy who want to learn more about sexual addiction and the ways it affects ministry and the Church. The program will focus on providing help for ministers and parishioners who are sexually addicted, and for congregations which have been affected by sexual misconduct.

This seminar is designed primarily for clergy and will give them information about:

- Identifying and assessing sexual addiction.
- Understanding how this addiction affects clergy.

- Getting help for the sexual addict: intervention with parishioners.
- Working with congregations that have been affected by the disease.

All of this information will be presented in a theological and Biblical context.

PRESENTERS

Rev. Mark R. Laaser, Ph.D., will lead the Institute's seminar, *Healing The Wounds: Sexual Addiction in the Church*. Program and materials were designed by Dr. Laaser and Patrick J. Carnes, Ph.D., a highly respected author and researcher in the fields of behavioral medicine and sexual addiction.

Dr. Laaser is an adjunct faculty member at the Golden Valley Institute for Behavioral Medicine. Additionally, Dr. Laaser is the alumni coordinator for Golden Valley Health Center's Sexual Dependency Unit, the nation's first 12-Step based inpatient unit for sexual addicts.

Dr. Laaser has taught courses and conducted seminars for colleges, seminaries, medical schools, hospitals, and other business and industry groups. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Augustana College, Rock Island, Illinois; a Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary; and a Doctorate degree in religion and psychology from the University of Iowa.

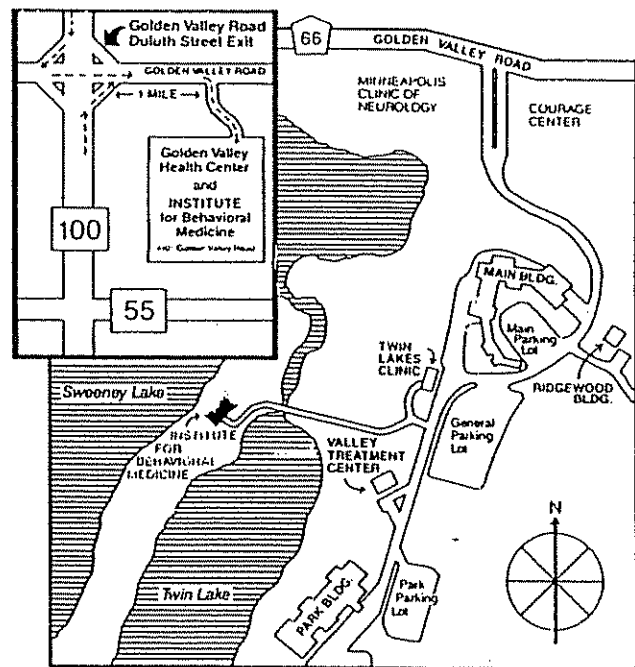
