DANIEL COOPER CLARK

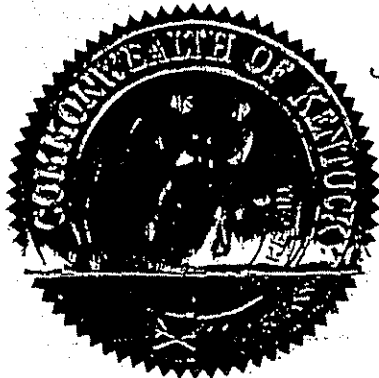
has been of an exemplary nature and merits the restoration of all civil rights lost by reason of conviction of a felony.
