

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, It is represented to me as Governor of Kentucky that # 88CR1051 DANIEL COPPER CLARK, was tried and convicted of the charge(s) of SEXUAL ABUSE I; SODOMY II in the Jefferson, Kentucky Circuit Court (X) or United States District Court () and was sentenced by said Court to serve a term of Fifteen (15) Years probated for Five (5) Years; and

WHEREAS, the said DANIEL COOPER CLARK was placed on probation on November 4th 1988, and the period of probation was terminated on November 4th 1993; and

WHEREAS, the said DANIEL COOPER CLARK has made application to have his/her civil rights restored and available evidence indicates s/he has complied with the necessary requirements;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 145 and 150 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, I, Brereton Jones, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, do hereby and now restore the right to vote and hold public office denied by judgment of conviction aforesaid and any prior conviction, to the said DANIEL COOPER CLARK and direct that all officials of this Commonwealth be governed accordingly. This order does not restore the right to receive, possess, or transport in commerce a firearm. Relief from this disability must be obtained through the Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms local office.
