 - St. Aloysius, Pewee Valley, Ky.
 - St. Thomas, St. Thomas, Ky. — 71-78 Bardstown.
 - St. Monica, Bardstown, Ky.
 - ✓ St. Augustine, Lebanon, Ky. - 79-83
 - ✓ A hospital in Lebanon, Ky. - don't know the name.
 - * Another church in Lebanon, for only a short time.
- Then to Canada -- the only church I know of there was
St. Columba
- then St. James - "Retired". Working at church, living in rectory
