Recently Lou's sister-in-law came to express her concerns over the impact of Lou's behavior with her children. The presumption is that allegations agianst Father Miller are correct unless proven otherwise. Mrs. Miller did not seek compensation but I believe some counseling has been arranged with Sister Eleanor Tierney.

In the course of these dealings, Walt Jones also expressed concern about Lou's present arrangement at Sacred Heart Home. This has been raised with me previously by Father Breen, I believe. This month we asked Dr. Wagner once again, and he offered assurance that Lou offered no danger in the current set-up. He goes to great lengths to avoid being around children. His background is known at Sacred Heart Home. In all my dealings with Lou, I have fouund him to be utterly repentant and horrified at his earlier behaviors. The judgments of Dr. Wagner and myself conclude that no change needs to be made.
