Dear Archbishop Kelly,

Greetings and Happy Easter! It has taken me some time to gather all the information needed to get matters moving ahead. However, information needed in the future should now be much easier to obtain.

As you suggested when we met on March 17, 1995, I contacted and interviewed with the Survivors of Clergy Abuse counselor. I will begin group counseling on April 12, 1995, at Our Lady of Peace from 5:00 until 6:30 every Wednesday evening. I am really looking forward to beginning the program and moving down the road to recovery and self-confidence.

Enclosed with this letter you will find itemized bills and statements. The pharmacy statements will reflect the total amount of money spent by me for prescriptions to this date. The total amount of \$331.66 is reflected on page four with all supporting information that you may need.

The statement from Dr. Carol Hammerbeck's office reflects the total activity as of April 4, 1995. I have taken the liberty of breaking down the payments and adjustments to show who received what amounts. The amount paid by me was \$182.00 with the remainder of credits being paid by Clear Springs. As you will see on the first page, the balance of the account, \$705.00, still remains to be paid. Dr. Hammerbeck's office has agreed to discontinue billing the insurance company and will allow me to send to you an invoice after each visit. My next office visit with her will be on April 25, 1995, at 1:15 PM. If these arrangements are not suitable for you, please let me know. Dr. Hammerbeck stated she would do whatever is necessary to accommodate your office procedures.

As we discussed, I have been carrying COBRA insurance from my previous place of employment. I was doing this in order to keep my

psychiatric benefits from being discontinued and because of the prescription rider. At the present time, my premium is paid until May 31, 1995. At that time, I will need to send another payment to continue coverage. The amount of \$537.80 reflects what I have paid to date to maintain my present coverage. We discussed very briefly the matter of discontinuing the COBRA insurance and the Diocese of Louisville assumes all medical expenses as they pertain to the recovery process of the sexual abuse by Fr. Wood. How do you wish me to handle this matter as I will have to contact my previous employer 30 days in advance to discontinue the coverage?

In summary, the total out of pocket expenses paid by me (as reflected by the enclosed receipts) is \$1051.46. Please note that I am still awaiting the itemized statements to arrive from Baptist Hospital East. As soon as I receive them I will forward them to your attention.

I have set an appointment with you on April 25, 1995, at 11.00 AM and I am looking forward to talking with you again. Thank you for your kindness, understanding, and wisdom.
