I asked him if had lied to us about what took place. He stated that did not lie and was truthful. I again asked if was truthful when he decribed the 20 Oct 88 incident. The suspect was again stated that was truthful.

The suspect also recanted on much of what he said about all of the boys he solicited, while speaking on tape. He admitted he was untruthful when he explained these situations to us. He also told us that when he spoke with the was soliciting him as well. He also stated he was attempting to do the same thing to-

The victim expressed his remorse at having done this to these victims. I mentioned at least one of the victims was very confused about why this had happened to him, by someone he trusted so much.
