## **MEMORANDUM**

TO: Bishop Michael Driscoll

FR: Reverend Monsignor John Urell

Chancellor/Moderator of the Curia

After reviewing Chris Andersen's requests, and after our discussion with Bishop McFarland, I would propose the following to be the way in which we proceed:

1. Set up another meeting with Chris

2. Let him know of the Bishop's stance viz a viz the necessity of pursuing the laicization petition NOW....and having the necessary documentation available for him when we meet with him to get it going

3. With assurance that he will do this, the Diocese would give him \$750.00 from the Priest's Relief Fund, beginning July 1, 1994....to be reviewed in 6 months (on January 15, 1995)

The amount of cash that he is asking the diocese for in his request is appoximately \$815.00 per month (this includes \$500 for housing, \$165 for insurance, \$50 for transportation (this means we don't give him a car) and \$100 for food).

He is also asking for counseling/therapy coverage; I would suggest that we have him try to take care of that himself with the money he will have.

From his reports, he makes approx. \$400/month now; with \$750 from the diocese, he would have \$1150.00 per month income. I realize that isn't a whole lot; but I also wonder if he has sought other employment (e.g. local rest homes for work, perhaps local restaurants for other work, etc.)

4. Finally, if Chris refuses to get going with the laicization process, he receives none of this. It has been 9+ years since he has served as a priest in the diocese....
