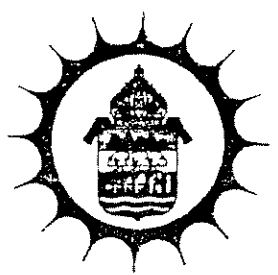

ALSO: There are a number of weddings that have been started but not finalized. All envelopes with information and all types of marriage forms are in the parish marriage file.

ALSO: Baptisms are usually held twice a month in Spanish: an average of 15-20 baptisms each month. I will cover the December baptisms; however, the rest of the months will have to be planned with the instructors and my priest replacement.

I usually try to provide a Saturday and a Sunday opportunity for Baptisms. The person in charge of the Baptismal pre-eatechesis is [REDACTED] OF Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Santa Ana, CA., who presently lives at [REDACTED] and who can be reached at phone # ([REDACTED])

ALSO: On Ash Wednesday, 20 February, the Spanish Mass will be at 7:00 P.M. I am sure that a lot of help will be needed for Mass and the distribution of the ashes.

ALSO: On Sunday, 23 March, at 9:30 A.M. and on Thursday, 27 March, at 7:00 P.M. an instruction on the Eucharist will have to be given to the parents of children in the first and second year of preparation to receive their first Eucharist. The format to be followed is up to the person giving the instruction.

I have usually given an introduction talk, followed by an audio-visual on the topic, then questions and answers in small discussion groups, and any other announcements.
