Father Michael Kerper called me today concerning Father Edward Avery. He wanted to explain some difficulties that have come up at the hospital with Father Avery.

The hospital administration wants to keep the services of Father Avery, and yet cannot have him acting as he has been. They have been reluctant to complain because they fear losing the services of a priest. Father Kerper told Mary Quirk, head of the Pastoral Care Department, he would call me.
