Dear Father Lynn,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Father Edward Avery is continuing in individual therapy with me. I met with the treatment team for Father Avery and the following changes have been made in his treatment plan:

The frequency of Father Avery's individual therapy sessions during this period will be determined by his activity level. If he appears to be following his stay-well-plan and providing the type of structure he needs for himself, he will be seen once per month. If he appears to be having difficulty doing this, the frequency of his sessions will increase according to need.

My view of this treatment approach for Father Avery continues to be positive and I anticipate he will continue to progress toward the goals we have discussed. Thank you for your support of Father Avery's treatment and your presence at his treatment team meeting in December.
