After much prayerful consideration, I now request from you's dispensation from the obligations connected and the preschool and from unbody. I ask to be returned to the lay state.

There are many reasons for my conocas. I now have had concerns about my ability to fulfill all of the shiggainne of the promishood.

I have been placed on eleministrative leave by the Archilecese of Philadelphia for one occasion of saxual misconduct with a minim. I have had to deal with this allegation since 1992. I one now 63 year old. The fact that this sexual inferentials has been to eight to the estention of both Church and civil subherities makes it unlikely that I can over serve in active ministry again. I do not believe that any aspect of the allegation presented by the Church authority is accurate, and I dony any sexual misconduct of any kind with a minor. This same allegation was theroughly investigated for a period of ton (10) months or 1993 and was declared "unlounded." I was welconed buch to the ministry by Anthony Cordinal Bevilaque and reassigned to hispanel. With the Bishups now pulicy of "screening the accusation was revisited and I was impended from invisity on Occanber 5,2003.

Since I was accused of second minorshoot. I have had the past twenty (20) minishe to consider the Issues surrounding my reasons for making this request. I was expressed by the civil authorities of any type of writighting after they had made a thorough investigation. Neaetheless the time away from pressity minisary has assisted me is discerning the fact that the priesthood is not the appropriate calling for me at this time because of the adverse publicity to the Church and myself. I am convinced it will not be in the finance.

I have not had a problem with unlikery during the years of ray primathook. A dispensation from the vew of collinery will assist one or living my lefe in a way that is appropriate to me. I have every intention of continuous to live a calibrat life.

The cruis in which I have found myself during these post munths has trought me to a deeper understanding about the concerns I have had about the obility of my vocation to survive this. This request is not a quick solution to a temperary problem, I find no alternative but to request lauszation.

I we fully aware that my decision to return to ley status, if approved by the Holy See, is permanent and final, without hope of eventual re-admittance to pricelly ministry.

I am currently in good physical, emotioned, and spiritual health. I have had no serious health concerns during my lifetime.
