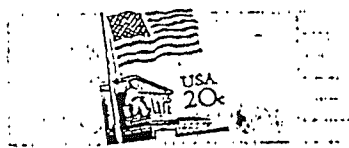

## Woman barred from church or meeting priests

A San Diego woman today was ordered to stay at least 75 yards away from St. Joseph's Cathedral and two of its priests.

Superior Court Judge J. H. Perry

REDA issued the order preventing

from attending any services

at the downtown church, posting no-

tices on the property or harassing the

priests, the Rev. Rudolph Galindo

and the Rev. Joseph Sum.

"I have no authority to deal with

organized religion, but I do have au-

thority to deal with pieces of real

property. I feel the refusal to allow

RED to worship on that particular

property is not error," Langford said.

"If I was issuing an order prevent-

ing a Moslem from visiting Mecca,

or preventing a Jew from visiting the

western wall (in Jerusalem), I don't

think it would be valid," Langford

said. "If in dealing with St. Joseph's

we were dealing with a basilica, it

might be different. But one can be a

Catholic without ever going into St.

Joseph's Cathedral.

Langford's order prevents R from

going within 75 yards of the block

bounded by Third and Fourth Ave-

nuet and Cedar and Beech Streets,

harrasing and annoying Rev. Galin-

do or Rev. Sum, telephoning the

priests or writing letters to them.

According to C. Joan Scimeca, at-

torney for the priests and the St. Jo-

seph's Parish Council, harassment of

Rev. Galindo by Do has lasted nearly

"She doesn't have the right to post notices on the doors and statues of St. Joseph's," Scimeca replied.

RE attorney, Michael J. Wagner, said that Do had a right to warn other women and that she did believe the seduction took place.

"She has the right to attend the church," Wagner argued. "I don't know how big the church is, but she could worship from the back of the church."

"She does interfere with our services. She has many other churches she can attend," Scimeca said.

According to the court documents RE has posted on church doors handwritten or typed notices referring to Rev. Galindo as "a crook of monies and love" and accusing him of "seducing women to love and give him monies."

"She told me in November that if Rev. Galindo paid her mortgage, she would not ask him for the full \$100,000. If he didn't, she would do this," Scimeca said.

Langford's order will prevent RE from attending the central area cathedral for at least three years.

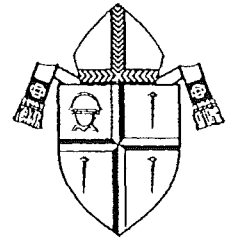

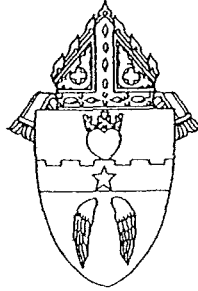


