## INVESTIGATION:

On 5-29-02, I received a Child Abuse Report dated 4-25-02 from Father Gerard LOPEZ, Director of Priest Personnel in San Bernardino. The report indicated Reverend James GANAHL, a family priest of the family, had molested four of the sisters in 1961.
On 5-31-02, I ta'ked who was surprised to hear from the police regarding this case. confirmed Reverend GANAHL molested her along with three of her sisters in 1961 when they lived in Mission Hills. Judy said they disclosed the molestation with the diocese in San Bemardino in 1990. $\square$ said the family made some type of financial settlement with the diocese in 1999 and were instructed, and they even signed a contract not tell anyone of the settlement asked if I would contact Father LOPEZ and finci out who reported the incident. said she would call her sisters and ask what they wanted to do regarding prosecuting Reverend GANAHL.

I called Father LOPEZ who said they were in the process of going through old files and were instructed by the parish to file CPS reports on any molestation case not reported to law enforcement. Father LOPEZ said they had 22 cases on file of child molestation dating back 30 years. He said the

I taiked to Deputy District Attorney Tia QUICK regarding this case. QUICK said if the family decides to go forward with prosecuting Reverend GANAHL, they might be liable to pay back any monies received from the diocese. QUICK advised me to have the contact a civil attorney and to have that attomey read their contract.

On 6-5-02, 1 talked to and explained to her what DOA QUICK advised them to do. I also told the parish was filling these CPS reports on their own without notifying the victims. Juaysaid she understood and said she talked it over with her sisters and they decided not to go forward with the investigation. said it would be to hard on the family since most of them live out of state. \& told to have her sister's call me if they needed any information regarding the CPS report NOPFACLURATE!

## CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

Eased upon my investigation, the victims do not want me to go any further with this case. They reported the incident to their parish in 1999 and received a tinaricial settlement. They requested a copy of the CPS report from San Bernardino which I supplied them with. This case is cancelled.
