Returned call from [redacted] - in Syracuse, N.Y.

She reported that Frank De Luca has abused his nephew, her son since 2001 when the lad was 13. (now 18 & has been to counseling)

She found out in July this year and has spoken to a lawyer and has talked to the Vicar for Clergy who referred her to me.

\*According to [redacted] the abuse has been continuous over the years whenever he was with Uncle Frank. Son's name is [redacted]

[redacted] W-006 is father called Frank and threatened to "kill him" - if he came near his son again.

9-26-06

Reported case to Msgr. Cini

Called Bishop Costello, Vicar of Priests in Syracuse,

he did not refer [redacted] to me and advised me to have her call him directly.

Called [redacted] who said that she did not talk to the Vicar of Priests in Syracuse. She talked to her sister in Michigan who talked to her priest who advised her to call me to report the matter to the authorities. I instructed her to call Bishop Costello. She asked what

will happen once reported, Told her the Bishop would explain that to her.

9-27-06 Brought Msgr. Cini up to date.

9-28-06 Called Bishop Costello: [redacted] did call him but not available until later today. When he speaks to her he will contact me.

10-2-06 Bishop Costello called:

Met with [redacted] Friday

Continuous abuse of W-006 [redacted] - younger brother [redacted] knows about it. "Seems to be a matter of touching." He has reported it to the District Attorney's Office. Referred W-006 [redacted] to their Victim's Assistance office. Will Wilmington cover counselling expenses? Yes - our policy - The Bishop will keep us informed.
