Your Eminence Amleto Giovanni Cicognani,

May I respectfully ask your assistance in finding a solution for the basic problems that at this moment are endangering the Paraclete Apostolate in the United States.

Setting aside personalities which will always present a difficulty to any work of zeal-"A man's worst enemies will be those of his own household". The present crises involve two policies or principles upon which a small group of Paracletes enjoying the backing of Archbishop Davis are unwilling to accept the founder's policies-

- 1) The first of these involves a question of the amount emphasis which is to be given the natural means of rebuild priestly lines.

Fr. Gerald--stands for emphasis on the spiritual-adequate but not all out-care of the body.

Opponents--complete physical, psychiatry, and psychological indoctrinations as preliminary to spiritual and continuing physical treatment.

Fr. Gerald's comment--The philosophy of today-down grades moral responsibility.(progressive denial of personal responsibility for transgressions--has progressed so far in the United States even Catholic United States that one is considered medieval minded to think of the excessive drinker as guilty of sin-especially grievous sin). This attitude being maintained in high places within the Church.

- 2) The question of Publicity

Fr. Gerald's--let us work quietly without any denial of facts yet no focusing of attention on our houses that would result in sick priests not wanting to come to us.

Opponents--big deal publicity e. g. The Cephas Apostolate--
see enclosed letters. *

What am I asking Your Eminence? I have asked Father Woerber our most loyal and efficient Assistant General to prepare and submit to you an eight point statement of the founder's principles--Ward Pope Paul to approve these in a letter to the Congregation.

I feel my hands would be greatly strengthened. I am all things accepting The Holy Father's directions with total docility.
