Garza car checked by Sgt. Ramirez - All doors locked except front right. Car was driven home by Mr. Garza in order that he might see who Irene was with when she was brought home. Gilbert Cavazos, brother-in-law of Irene, parked nearby until 6AM in the event Irene returned he was to see who she was with and tell her where the car was.

 at the house.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION: Alfredo Barrera, 707 South 10th Street, teacher at
 Edinburg public schools, found purse in field adjoining Northeast intersection of
 McColl Road and FM 495. Purse was closed and Barrera opened it and after seeing
~~money stolen~~ belonged to Irene took it to the Garza residence.

According to evidence in field as found by Officer Brooks and FBI Agent Harold
 Rossett the purse has been thrown from McColl Road in an Easterly direction some
 time after heavy portion of the rain Easter evening. The purse had evidence of soil
 on it. The soft earth was pushed in an easterly direction and remained so
~~name and description of suspect~~ pushed indicating the heavy rain did not fall on the
 displaced loam. The purse was examined for fingerprints by use of oblique light-
 ing and a magnifying glass. No latent prints of any significance were noticed. It
~~Details of investigation~~ was later carried to Austin where the development of latent
 prints were attempted. None were found.

The Sheriff's Posse was called by Chief Deputy Tom Wingert and a search was
 organized North to State Highway 107 approximately 9 miles. The Posse searched
 south to the Military Highway approximately 10 miles. The National Guard searched
 south of McAllen to Military Highway approximately 9 miles. Many other volunteer
 searchers were working.

Field at this location was clear of growth - sandy loam was soft as a bulldozer
 had recently been working doing some clearing. The purse was 102 feet from the
 pavement of McColl Road and 123 feet from the pavement of Highway 495.

 Details of offense There is a woman's body in canal on 2nd Street across from Sears.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION: Body was face down floating in canal East of the South
 driveway to Sears parking lot. Justice of the Peace Harley Jackson at scene. Body
 taken from canal by use of a piece of canvas furnished by McAllen Fire Dept.
 Among officers present at scene were Brooks, Sheriff Vickers, Chief Deputy Tom
~~Deputy~~ Wingert, Chief Mussey, and FBI Agent Harold Crossett. Body was taken to
 Reidler Funeral Home. Autopsy details were arranged by Sheriff Vickers and Chief
 Deputy Wingert. Photographs were taken at Morgue by Brooks. The body was
 identified at Morgue by Father O'Brien and Gilbert Cavazos. The body was fully
 clothed except for panties and shoes. The blouse was unbuttoned. The brassiere
 was intact.

~~Name and description of suspect~~
 Search by the Mounted Posse and National Guard was cancelled when body was found.
 Officers continued searching for other shoe, panties and point of entrance into
 canal.

Details of Investigation: ~~canal.~~
 I. A. Albert and Henry Canty, polygraph examiners from Texas Department of Public
 Safety, who were in McAllen this date in regard to an investigation of a major
 highway accident were contacted. Homer Garrison, Jr., Director of the Texas
 Department of Public Safety was contacted at Austin and his permission was given
 for the examiners to stay in McAllen as long as needed. Examinations were started
 in afternoon of 4-21-60. Polygraph examinations were continued thru April 29th at
 which time a total of 49 subjects had been examined. They were resumed again
 May 7th and 8th during which time 11 were examined. One subject was examined in
 Austin (Trac) making a total of 61 subjects.

Details of offense: Efforts toward finding the missing articles were expanded, additional neighborhood canvasses for information were begun. On April 22nd Deputy Sheriff Jordan found evidence at the canal crossing at Houston Avenue and Second Street which proved to be location where body was placed in canal. Casts were made of a shoe track and an impression made by dead girls can-can slip. The cast of a heel print contained a hair identical with hair of deceased. A cast was made of a drag mark made by body being dragged into canal. These casts were carried to D.P.S. ~~Police~~ Laboratory as well as clothing found on the body and the shoe for analysis and examination. Extra investigators were obtained from the U.S. Border Patrol and the Texas Department of Public Safety. Conferences were held with heads of various law enforcement agencies as well as FBI Agents. Investigative procedures were discussed and planned. Thirty two square blocks surrounding the Sacred Heart Church were canvassed house to house. The area around Houston Avenue and 2nd Street ~~was~~ was canvassed house to house. McColl Road and cross roads were canvassed house to house from U.S. #83 to State 107. Motels and Hotels were checked in McAllen, Pharr and Edinburg. Taxicabs, rent cars, air lines, ~~Details of Investigation~~ Mexican Consulate, Office, Moore Field and Harlingen Air Force Base. Local sex offenders were checked. Pleas for information were made by newspapers, radio and television. Photographs of girl and clothing, missing shoe and purse were run in paper and on TV. Pan American College in Edinburg was checked for suspects absentees from Pan American College following April 18th were checked. An investigation into the incident at the Sacred Heart Church in Edinburg on March 2 was checked. Statement from witness^{es} and suspects were taken.

Details of offense Numerous leads, many anonymous, were checked. Paint shops in McAllen, Edinburg, Pharr, Mission and Reynosa checked on painting of blue and white car. An article was run in D.F.S. Law Enforcement Bulletin D-4-1238, 5-12-60. Girl friends, boy friends and acquaintances of Irene were interviewed and statements are taken. Subjects were checked in El Paso, Hillsboro, Yoakum, Austin and in 11 Valley towns from Rio Grande City to Brownsville to Raymondville.
