F. Birmingham was present at the Chansey office to be confronted by the two boys and their fathers who had accused him of improper conduct. F. Hurler, the pastor, had come to Chansey <sup>a few days before</sup> to bring this matter to official attention and Mr. Sexton intervened. F. Birmingham to acquaint him with these complaints.

F. B. denied them and today's meeting was unchanged.

Present were Mr. Sexton, Mr. Frimman, F. Hurler, F. Birmingham, Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], Mr. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] related how his son [REDACTED] told the F. B. "put his hands inside his pants and fondled his private parts." It had also happened "last year" in the racists and in the kitchen. [REDACTED] had reacted and "F. B. asked if it felt good." One occasion F. B. asked if he was ticklish - but the father muffled in and no fondles took place at that time.

[REDACTED] - told similar story regarding his son, [REDACTED]. The incidents happened on two occasions. Most recently, about a month ago, when after today's meeting had started. [REDACTED] went to his mother and told the story. She told Mr. [REDACTED] and it was brought to pastor's attention.

F. Birmingham at first claimed these accounts "were not true." He claimed the circumstances were

with mutual ex play - but Mrs. Sexton and Mr. [redacted] spoke up & advised F. B. & the alleged incidents themselves. F. B. has said that, with [redacted] - "it was a spontaneous gesture of getting him around the waist". Did not touch his p/parts. [redacted] boy answered, in reply & question by Mrs. Sexton, "F. B.'s hands were inside my pants, inside my underwear". F. B. then was questioned regarding the incident with [redacted] and he "did not remember", "I trust to God".

It was then brought out that these incidents could have involved other boys with F. B.

A [redacted] of [redacted] police had stated it could have happened to his boy. There was two boys and an [redacted] said "this had happened to all the boys." The [redacted] boy had said that F. B. had once tickled him. F. Hinkley pointed out that another boy had denied it.

"The [redacted] boy had told his father 'it did happen and it did occur twice' - 'F. B. put his hands inside my pants and touched my p/parts.'"

Mrs. Sexton asked to and received F. B.'s apology for the "impropriety."

Further talk with the boys' fathers and F. H. indicated that this knowledge is widespread.

Boys have talked of it. Parents (of at least 5) are

CCO etc. Mr. [redacted] "not a real practicing Catholic,  
quite very upset etc etc." Mr. Sexton told Fr. H.  
to speak with Mr. [redacted].

Mr. Sexton assured the father that Fr. E.  
would be transferred immediately. Fr. B. asked if he  
could stay until Feb. so it would appear to be a routine  
transfer, and he had many projects etc. etc.

Mr. Sexton pointed out this was irregular  
and that Fr. B. was to make immediate appointment  
with Cth. psychiatrist to get to the root of his  
problem and seek help from his Spiritual  
Director. It was given the name and phone no.  
of Dr. Quinn (?) and told to make the appointment  
right away. His transfer would be in the  
mail within a day or so - and he would be placed  
on sick leave, in all likelihood - and the people  
need to be told that he had been "working  
too hard" and "needed a rest." Every effort  
would be made to send Fr. H. a replacement,  
but "we're short of men at this time of year",  
Mr. Sexton pointed out and, finally, he might  
not get help until Ordination in Feb.

Hurley, the pastor, had come to Chancery a few days before to bring this matter to official attention and Msgr. Sexton interviewed Fr. Birmingham to acquaint him with their complaint. Fr. B. denied them and today's meeting was arranged.

Present were Msgr. Sexton, Msgr. Finnegan, Fr. Hurley, Fr. Birmingham, [redacted] and [redacted]

[redacted] related how his son [redacted] told that Fr. B. "put his hands inside his pants and touched his private parts." It had also happened "last year" in the sacristy and in the kitchen. [redacted] had erection and "Fr. B. asked if it felt good." One occasion Fr. B. asked if he was ticklish - but the janitor walked in and no touches took place at that time.

[redacted] - told similar story regarding his son, [redacted]. The incidents happened on two occasions. Most recently, about a month ago, when altar boys' meetings had started. [redacted] went to his mother and told the story. She told [redacted] and it was brought to pastor's attention.

Fr. Birmingham at first claimed these accounts "were not true." He claimed the circumstances were different. These two boys had been concerned with mutual sex play - but Msgr. Sexton and [redacted] spoke up to restrict Fr. B. to the alleged incidents themselves. Fr. B. then said that, with [redacted] - "it was a spontaneous gesture of grabbing him around the waist." Did not touch his p/parts. [The boy answered, in reply to question by Msgr. Sexton, "Fr. B.'s hands were inside my pants, inside my underwear]. Fr. B. then was questioned regarding the incident with [redacted] and he "did not remember", "honest to God"

It was then brought out that these incidents could have involved other boys with Fr. B. A [redacted] of [redacted] police had stated it could have happened to his boy. These two boys and an [redacted] said "this had happened to all the boys." The [redacted] boy had said that Fr. B. had once tickled him. Fr. Hurley pointed out that another boy had denied it.

The [redacted] boy had told his father "it did happen and it did occur twice" - "Fr. B. put his hands inside my pants and touched my pr/parts."
