

I AM WELL PHYSICALLY, FINANCIALLY

ANXIOUS AS TO WHATS GOING ON  
OVER HERE. I PLANNED A LETTER

I REACHED FROM MR. G. N. JOHNSON,  
JUST TO LET YOU KNOW I'M "DOING MY  
JOB".

ALSO, I WISH TO INFORM YOU THAT UPON  
COMPLETION OF MY "TOUR OF DUTY", I  
PLAN TO RETURN TO ST. LOUIS AS A PRIEST  
IN THE ARCTIC DIocese OF BOSPERN. I AM PLANNED  
TO GET OUT OF THE ARMY IN SEPT. OF  
1941. NECESSITY <sup>TO SAY</sup> THE ARMY WANTS ME TO  
STAY ON ACTIVE DUTY; BUT I HAVE  
MADE UP MY MIND TO RETURN HOME
